Responding to issues in your community

During the month of October, there was a total of 291 investigations in the Felixstowe and District.

(Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Each ward has been affected by, residential /garage / shed burglaries, thefts from motor vehicles, criminal damage and ASB incidents. Investigations also include, reassurance and crime reduction surveys.

Making the community safer

Mobile patrols were stepped up during the Halloween and Fireworks party weekends to combat any ASB related incidents. Apart from a very few isolated incidents, there was generally a much reduced number of reports in the area this year.

Leaflets and posters had been distributed around local shops to deter the sale of flour and eggs to young children prior to Halloween.


