GET IN TOUCH

We wanted to remind you of the many ways you can get in touch with us. Most importantly, if it's an emergency always ring 999. However, if it's not an emergency but you wish to report a crime or a concern for safety then use 101. If you simply wish to contact your local team, perhaps to tell us about Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) or a series of crimes occurring in your area, or to tell us about your concerns about how the police have handled a local community matter, why not in the first instance speak with your local Sergeant and discuss the matter with them? Your local Sergeants will be able to review the matter and make an assessment about how well we did, reporting back to you with their findings. Your local community Sergeants are Anna Whybro and Lisa Vaughan. If you want to speak to your local officer and it's not urgent then an email will be quickest means to get in contact, and if you need a reply than a member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs. Remember, the demand on 101 is very high and if you don't need to report a crime we would encourage the use of email.

Suffolk Police are launching a New Year #CouldYouBeSpecial campaign to attract recruits into the Special Constabulary. Being a member of the Special Constabulary opens up a range of special opportunities; to volunteer, to connect with your community, to get new skills, to extend your personal limits, to reduce harm, to inspire others to join, to make others and yourself proud of what you a difference you can make. Becoming part of a diverse organisation that fights crime in the county, it is also a positive way to try police work if you are considering a career as a full time officer.

Special Constables are volunteer officers who give their time to assist the regular police force in keeping communities in Suffolk safe. Committed recruits, keen to experience the rewards and challenges of policing are being actively sought. The role of a Special Constable includes providing high visibility patrols and helping to police major incidents and events. They also offer vital links in the partnership between the police service and the public.

If you are 18 years or older, in good health and of good character, you can apply. Full training will be given so that you can become part of a team that deals with a variety of incidents and events across Suffolk.

Karen Harris, Specials Manager said, "We are actively recruiting volunteer police officers to be stationed all around Suffolk.
