
### You said...

### Responding to issues in your community

During the month of January 2019 there were a total of 262 investigations in Woodbridge (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Parishes have been affected by, residential / garage / shed burglaries, thefts from motor vehicles, criminal damage and ASB incidents. Investigations also include reassurance and crime reduction surveys.

### Making the community safer

Following the Policing restructure in October 2018 the Safer Neighbourhood Team have been working closely with the new Link Officer and PCSO to address local ASB issues in your area. "Street meets" will be taking place in order for the Police to hear the concerns of those affected by continued ASB and work with partner agencies to come to a resolution.

A number of areas in Suffolk have been experiencing a rise in the theft from Motor Vehicles. We advise that you secure your vehicle and refrain from leaving any valuables inside your vehicles overnight.

### Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

PCSO Gemma Read has started her new fully funded role in Kesgrave and Rushmere St Andrew. Based at the North East Safer Neighbourhood Team Office on Heath Road Ipswich PCSO Gemma Read will be tasked to undertake visible patrols, tackle low level ASB and provide any local policing advice as required. There will be a chance for members of the public to speak to their PCSO during regular Police Surgeries.
