Freedom of Information Request Reference N^o: FOI 001569/19

I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies on the 26th April 2019 in which you sought access to the following information:

Please provide a record of all gifts, donations and sponsorship given to your force by third parties for operational purposes, under section 93 of the Police Act 1996.

This might be, for example, a private company providing a car, equipment, or funding to the force for police use, in some cases in return for police presence at particular events or location.

For each donation, please provide:

- A The name of each donor, the value of the donation
- B What the donation to the force was (if it was a donation of money or of goods such as a vehicle etc)
- C Any record of what the donation was used for.
- D All other fields relating to these donations as held in your recording system.

Please provide information for the period April 1st 2014 to April 1st 2019.

Please note, this is not a request for information for small personal gifts or hospitality provided, as would be disclosed in your register of senior staff interests, but for donations to the police service as a whole, for operational use.

As an example, the Metropolitan Police records this information in this format:

Please note that companies, or individuals with a public profile do not have a reasonable expectation of privacy around these donations under DPA 2018 given the non-sensitivity of this data, and the fore knowledge that police forces are subject to high standards of public disclosure regarding their finances.
