## **Freedom of Information Request Reference N°: FOI 002552-19**

I write in connection with your request for information received by Suffolk Constabulary on the 15 July 2019 in which you sought access to the following information:

*“I would be very grateful if you could provide some statics figures which might be helpful for my son’s transport appeal next Monday 22nd July. I require information on how many collisions reported at around this T- junction ( Old church lane, Hill Road and Fornham Lane in Westley village, Bury St Edmunds over last few years. It would be particularly helpful if you have information if anyone was seriously injured.*

*Is there anyone I could contact who can tell me if there have been any speeding tickets issued around the same junction?”*

### **Response to your Request**

The response provided below is correct as of 19 July 2019

Suffolk Constabulary has considered your request for information and the response is below.

The Constabulary has completed a search of the Road Traffic Collisions recorded by the Road Collisions Support Team from 2016 to date. The Constabulary did not locate any RTCs in the location requested during the time.

***Please note that Suffolk Constabulary is only able to retrieve data for those road traffic collisions that have been reported to the Police. There may be additional collision the force is unaware of.***

The Constabulary has located the following speeding offences at the site in the village of Westley on the C688 Hill Road. This does not pinpoint exact location however and so we cannot confirm whether the offences were specifically at the location requested.

Your Right to Request a Review of Decisions Made Under the Terms of the  
Freedom of Information Act (2000).

If you are unhappy with how your request has been handled, or if you think the decision is incorrect, you have the right to ask Suffolk Constabulary to review their decision.

Ask Suffolk Constabulary to look at the decision again.

If you are dissatisfied with the decision made by Suffolk Constabulary under the Freedom of Information Act (2000), regarding access to information, you must notify Suffolk Constabulary that you are requesting a review within 40 working days of the date of its response to your Freedom of Information request.
