I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies on the 7th August 2018 in which you sought access to the following information:

Please could you provide us with a list of all female victims of homicide killed in 2017 which your authority has been responsible for investigating and, for each victim:

- the age of the victim;
- the sex of the accused;
- the date of the homicide;
- the ethnicity of the victim;
- the name of the victim and the accused;
- the relationship between the accused and the victim; and
- if identified, the way in which the victim was killed.
