I write in connection with your request for information received by Suffolk Constabulary on the 20 August 2018 in which you sought access to the following information:

"I am writing to ask for a Freedom of Information for Barnard Square up until now please.

It would be crime and anti-social behaviour including call data for Barnard square please. If I could have from the start of February 2017 until today would be great please."

Response to your Request

The response provided below is correct as of 30 August 2018

Suffolk Constabulary has considered your request for information and the response is below.

A search has been completed of the Constabulary's call data for all incidents recorded by the Constabulary from 1 February 2017 to date, in the location of Barnard Square using search parameters of postcodes IP2 8FD – IP2 8FJ.

The data provided relies on the location field being completed correctly with the name 'Barnard Square'. Any relevant calls that do not contain this location detail will not be included within the response.

Please note that the data provided relates to calls received as opposed to crimes recorded.

Freedom of Information Act (2000).

If you are unhappy with how your request has been handled, or if you think the decision is incorrect, you have the right to ask Suffolk Constabulary to review their decision.

Ask Suffolk Constabulary to look at the decision again.

If you are dissatisfied with the decision made by Suffolk Constabulary under the Freedom of Information Act (2000), regarding access to information, you must notify Suffolk Constabulary that you are requesting a review within 20 days of the date of its response to your Freedom of Information request.
