I write in connection with your request for information received by the Norfolk and Suffolk Constabularies on the 16th September 2019 in which you sought access to the following information:

Please supply me with officer and staff conviction data broken down as follows:
The number of staff and officer convictions, for the years of 2008 and 2018 (Jan 1 - Dec 31 of both years) listed by the year of conviction, the offence and the outcome.

If your records do not go back as far as 2008 then I will accept the earliest year you have records for after 2008 and 2018 (the years between are not being requested).

CLARIFICATION:-

Please note that this request is not in regards to convictions of staff and officers either before or after their employment with the force, and is only for staff and officers who were convicted while still in employment by the force at the time, even if they were on suspension at the time.

The conviction in 2018 was for an offence contrary to sections 55(3) and 60(2) of the Data Protection Act 1998. The outcome was a fine of £1000, victim surcharge of £200 and £85 costs.
