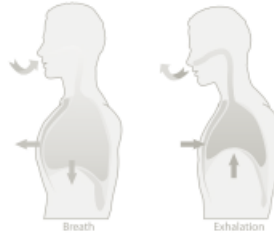

ADVANCED INCAPACITANT

- Contact lenses inhibit the natural effect of tears in flushing the surface of the eye.
- Contact lenses must be removed as soon as possible following exposure for faster recovery!
- This must be done by the individual, an optician, or a medical practitioner.
- Irrigate with cool clean running water.
- Soft lenses need to be disposed of due to absorption of PAVA.

AfterCare Do's & Don'ts

- Immediately after spraying advise to keep eyes closed.
 - Rubbing the eyes or face will aggravate the effects.
- **Note:** The immediate application of water or saline to the effected area increases the burning sensation.
 - Standing the subject facing cool moving air such as a fan or a breeze is most soothing.
- Experience has shown that the earlier the subject forces themselves to open their eyes and unimpeded tearing takes place, the quicker the recovery.
 - **Note:** Trying to open the eyes is very uncomfortable but increases visual recovery rapidly.
