*How many people have been killed on your roads within your force area where the person who was responsible for that death was between the legal driving age or younger and 25*

*How many people between the legal driving age or younger and 25 have been charged with any of the following offences*

*Please provide name of victim and age at time of death*

*Causing Death by Dangerous Driving*

*Causing Death by Careless Driving*

*Causing Death While Disqualified*

*Causing Serious Injury by Driving While Disqualified*

*Causing death through careless driving when unfit through drink*

*Causing death by careless driving when unfit through drugs*

*Causing death by careless driving with alcohol level above the limit*

*Causing death by careless driving then failing to supply a specimen for alcohol analysis*

*Causing death by careless, or inconsiderate, driving*

*Causing death by driving: unlicensed, disqualified or uninsured drivers*

*Manslaughter or culpable homicide while driving a vehicle*

*In charge of a vehicle while alcohol level above limit*

**CLARIFICATION:**

*I do not require the name of the victims as FOI's can be put on public register and friends and family of the victim may not be upset without should they ever see it , even though the principal remains the same dead people have no right to privacy*

*So please supply just victims age there name is not required"*

# SUFFOLK CONSTABULARY

A search has been completed of the Constabulary's traffic justice system for all Road Traffic Collisions (RTCs) recorded between 2014 – 2016, where by the responsible driver was aged 25 years and under.

The information excludes fatal RTCs where the driver was the only person in the vehicle.

The total number of fatal road traffic collisions (RTCs) and the number of subsequent prosecutions, is as follows:

Year	Number of RTCs	Number of prosecutions
2014	0	0
2015	1	1
2016	1	0

The victims were 21 and 42.
