I write in connection with your request for information received by Suffolk Constabulary on the 7 August 2017 in which you sought access to the following information:

1. *"Please state the number of people currently on police bail (under investigation and awaiting a decision on charges) after being arrested by your force.*
2. *Of the people in part 1, what is the longest amount of time that an individual has been on police bail without charge?*
3. *Of the people in part 1, please state how many have been on pre-charge police bail without charge for longer than six months.*
4. *Please provide a breakdown of the people in part 1 by suspected offence.*

Could you also please tell me:

5. *The number of people who are not on bail, but have been interviewed under caution and the cases are still active.*
6. *The number of people currently being investigated as a volunteer.*
7. *The number of people in total who have been arrested in the last year. If possible, please break this down by suspected offence.*
8. *The number of people charged with any offence in the last year. If possible, please break this down by offence."*

Response to your Request

The response provided below is correct as of 7 August 2017

Suffolk Constabulary has considered your request for information and the response is below.

A search has been completed of the Constabulary's custody data for all persons currently on police bail including data prior to and since the introduction of 'Released Under Investigation' (RUI). Further details of which are available on our website and should be reviewed in correlation with the response given the distinct differences between bail as was, and RUI:

1. As of the 31 July 2017, a total of 867 people are RUI and a total of 382 persons are on police bail.
2. The longest time an individual has been on bail as at 31 July is 343 days.
3. There were a total of 137 people who, as of 31 July, had been on bail without charge.

Police forces in the United Kingdom are routinely required to provide crime statistics to government bodies and the recording criteria is set nationally. Section 23(5) – Information supplied by, or concerning, certain security bodies



The duty to confirm or deny does not arise if, or to the extent that, compliance with section 1(1)(a) would involve the disclosure of any information (whether or not already recorded), which was directly or indirectly supplied to the public authority by, or relates to, any bodies specified in subsection (3).

This is an absolute exemption and I am therefore not required to complete a public interest test.

This cannot be taken as confirmation or otherwise that further information does or does not exist.

Your Right to Request a Review of Decisions Made Under the Terms of the
Freedom of Information Act (2000).

If you are unhappy with how your request has been handled, or if you think the decision is incorrect, you have the right to ask Suffolk Constabulary to review their decision.

Ask Suffolk Constabulary to look at the decision again.

If you are dissatisfied with the decision made by Suffolk Constabulary under the Freedom of Information Act (2000), regarding access to information, you must notify Suffolk Constabulary that you are requesting a review within 20 days of the date of its response to your Freedom of Information request.
