### 1) Total stop account / search figures

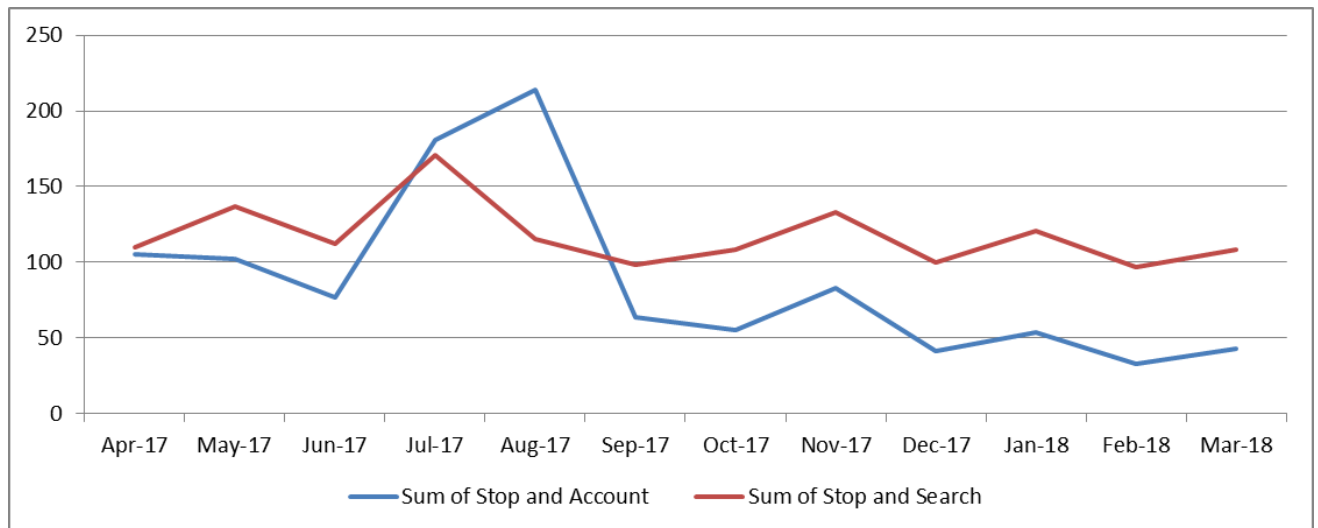


Figure 1: 12 monthly figures as of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018

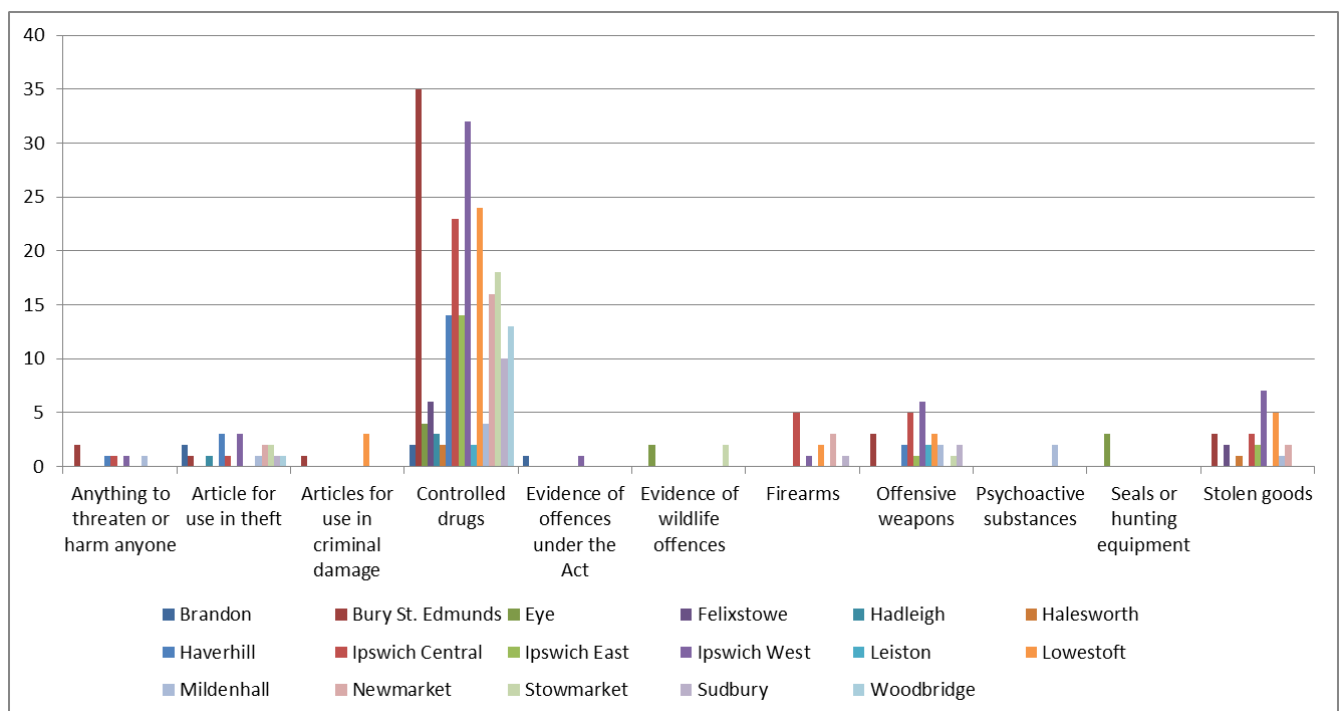


Figure 2: Object of search by area

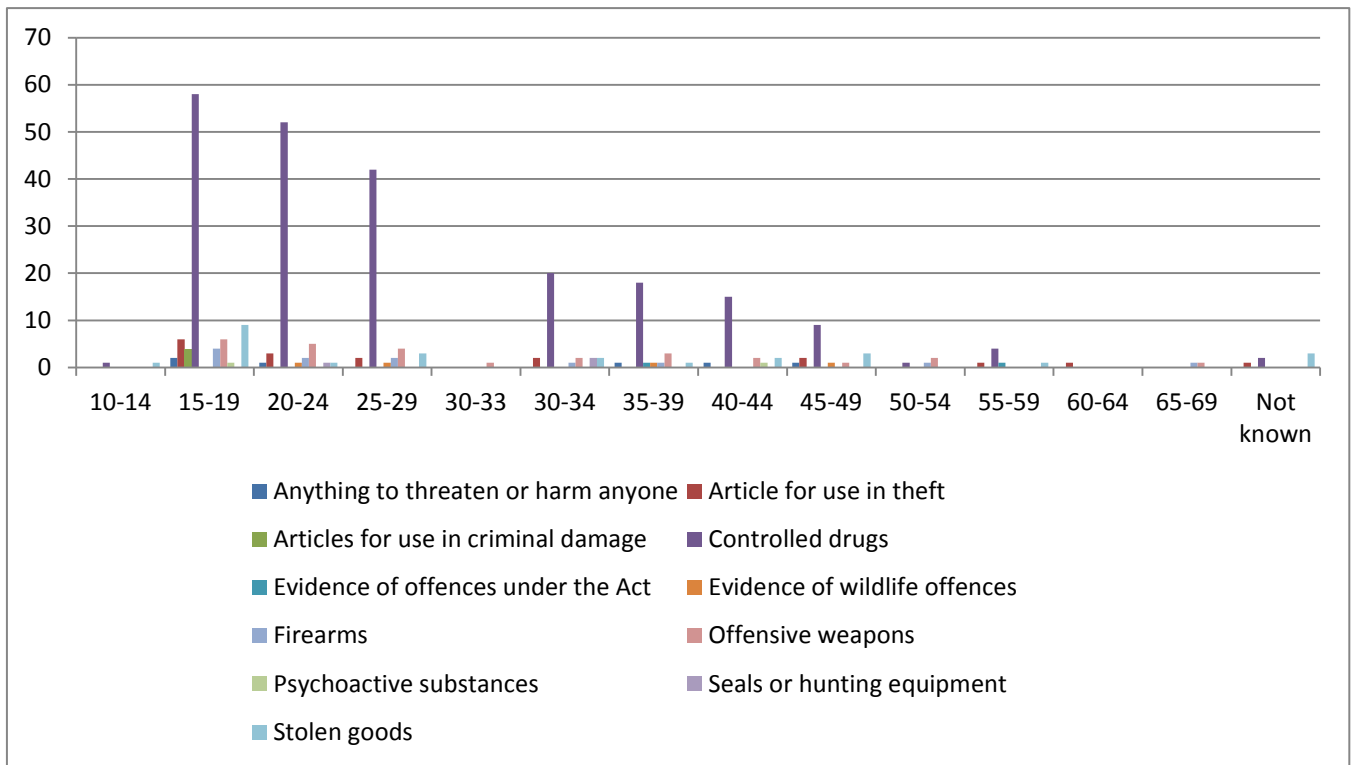


Figure 3: Object of search by age group

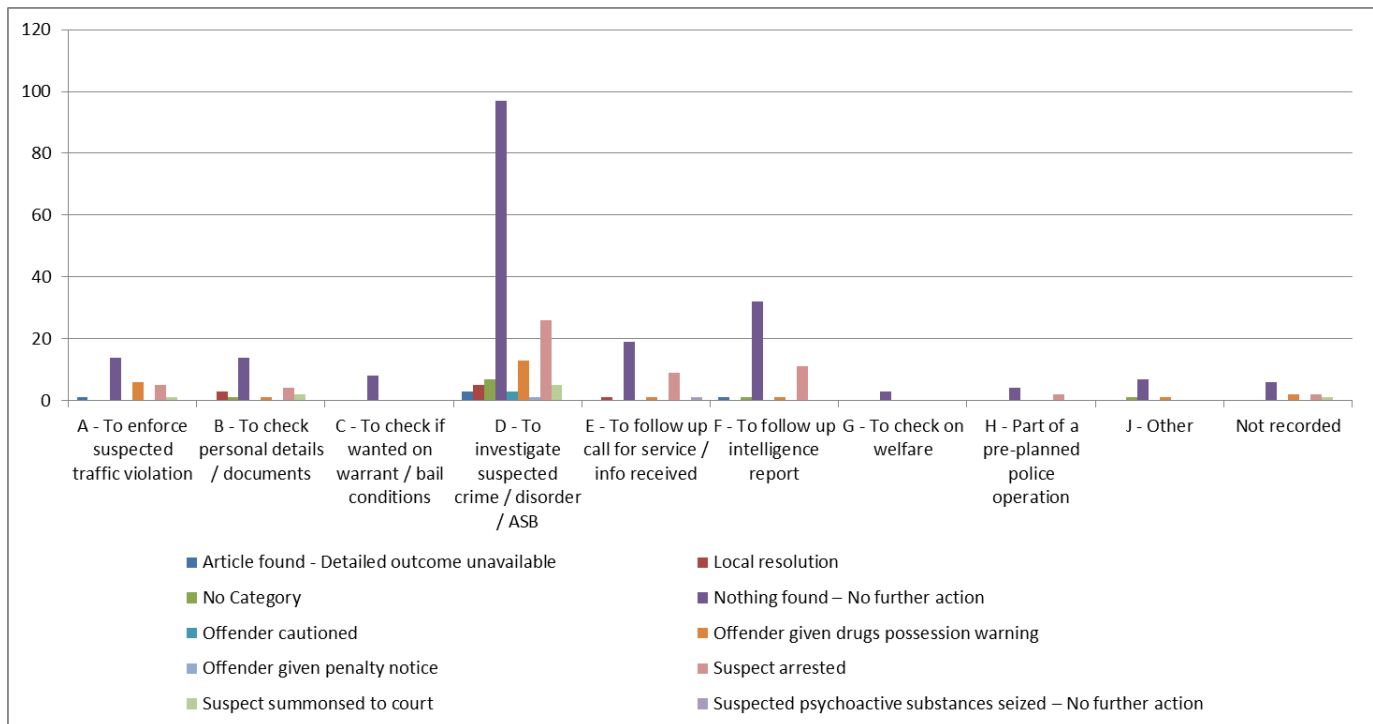


Figure 4: Reason for stop and search against outcome

Of the 42 strip searches, there was a total of:

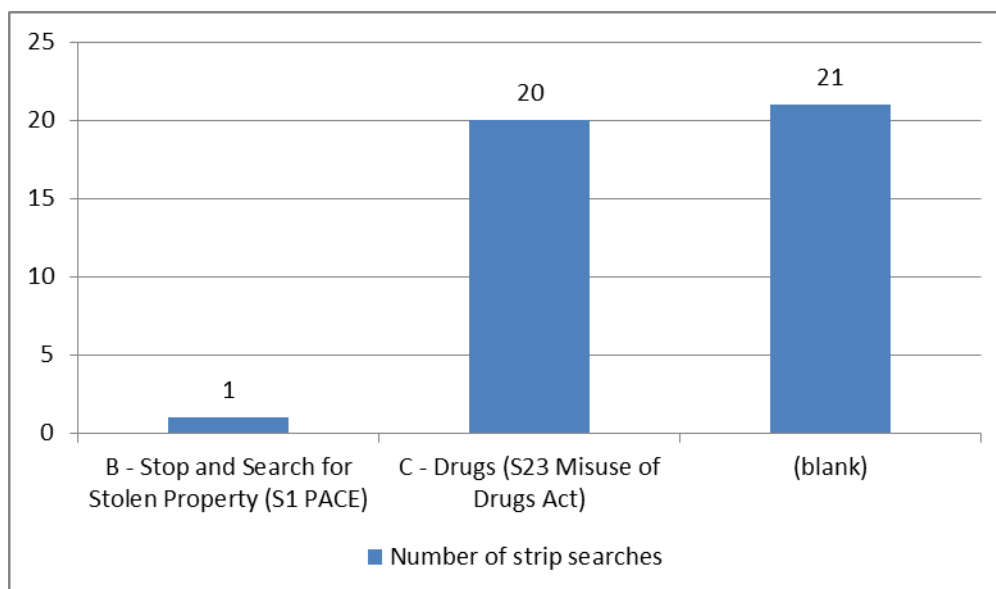


Figure 5: Strip search by reason for search

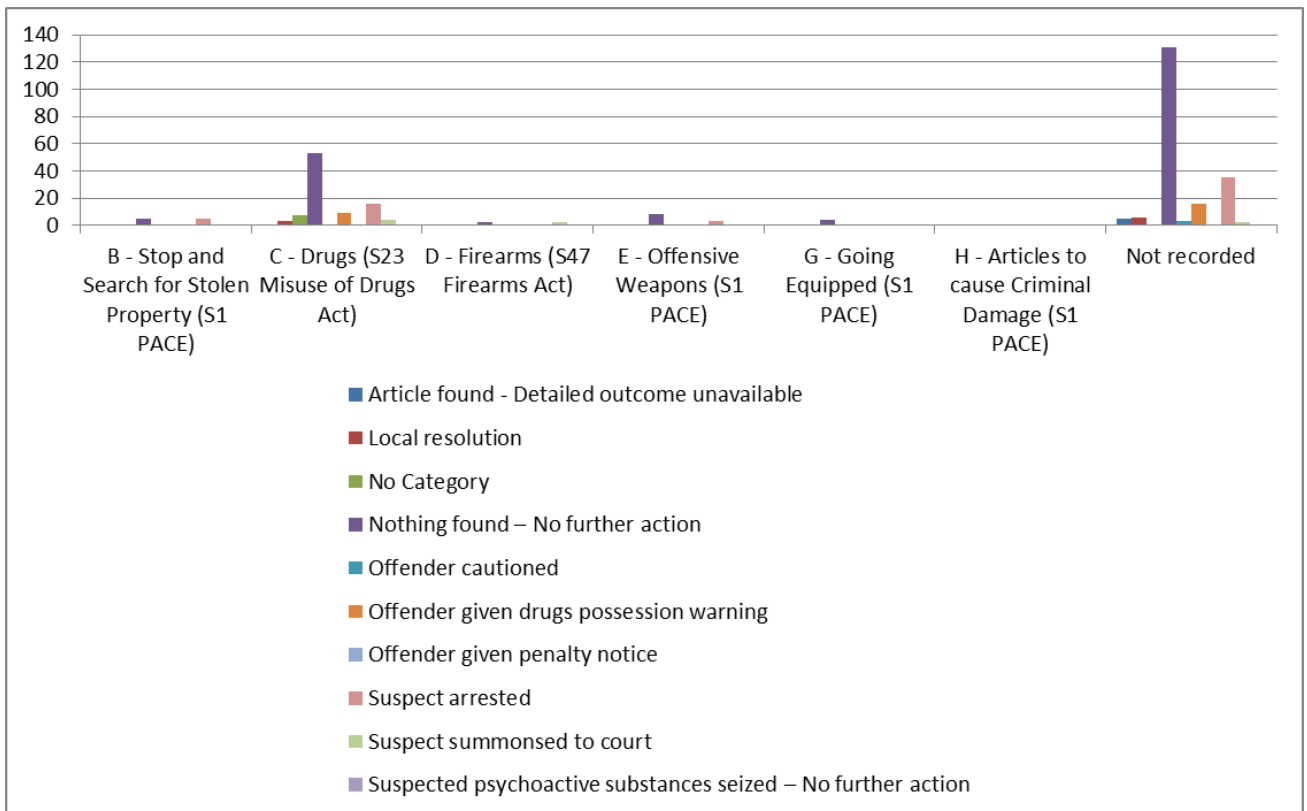


Figure 6: Outcome against reason for search

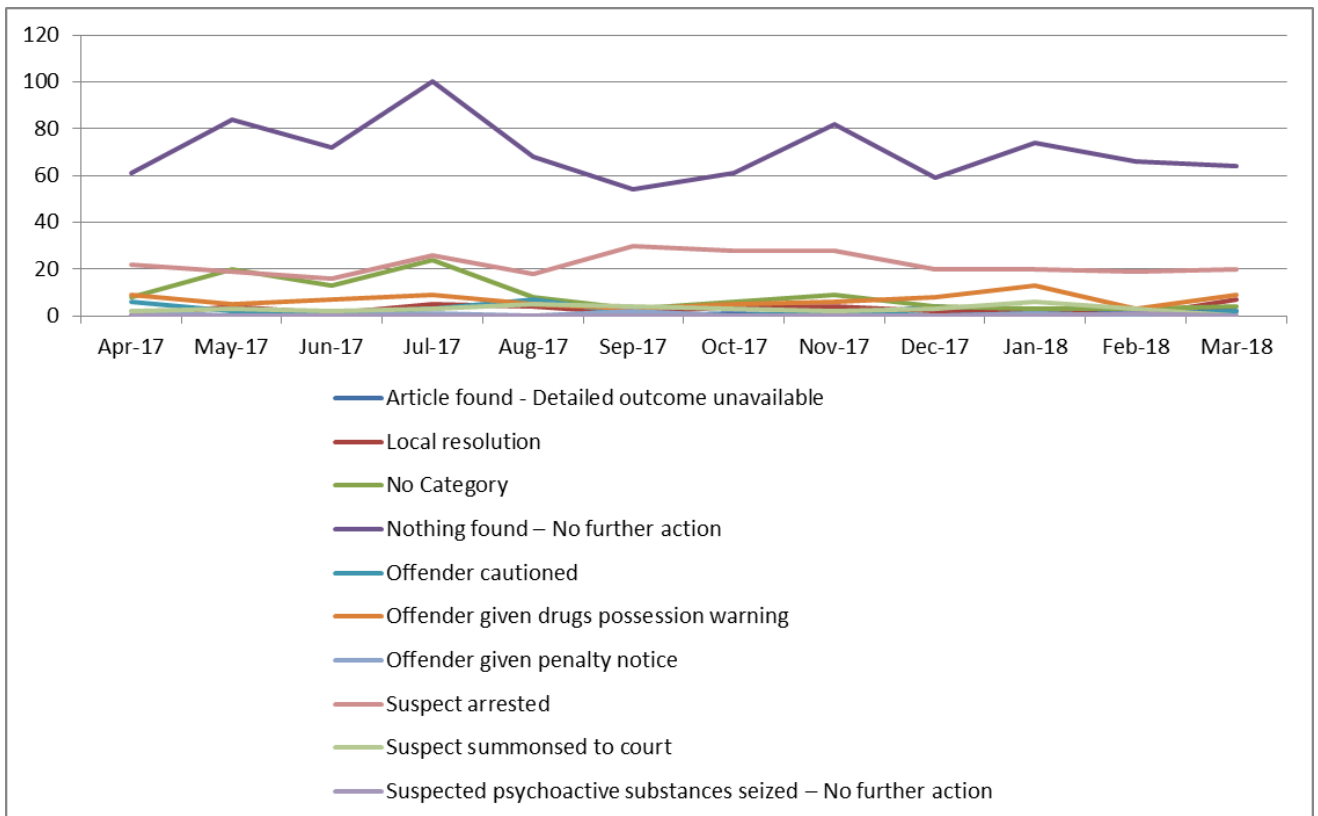


Figure 7: 12 months outcome data

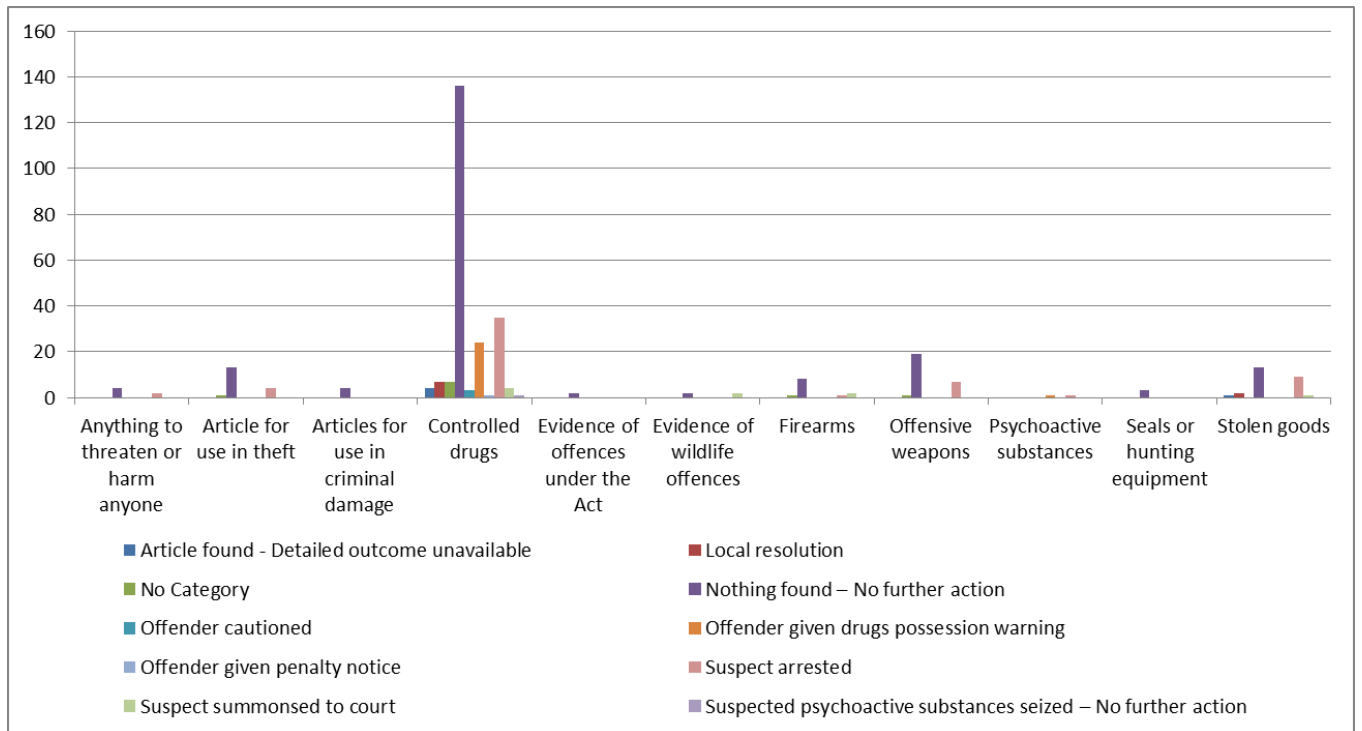


Figure 6: Object of stop and search vs the outcome

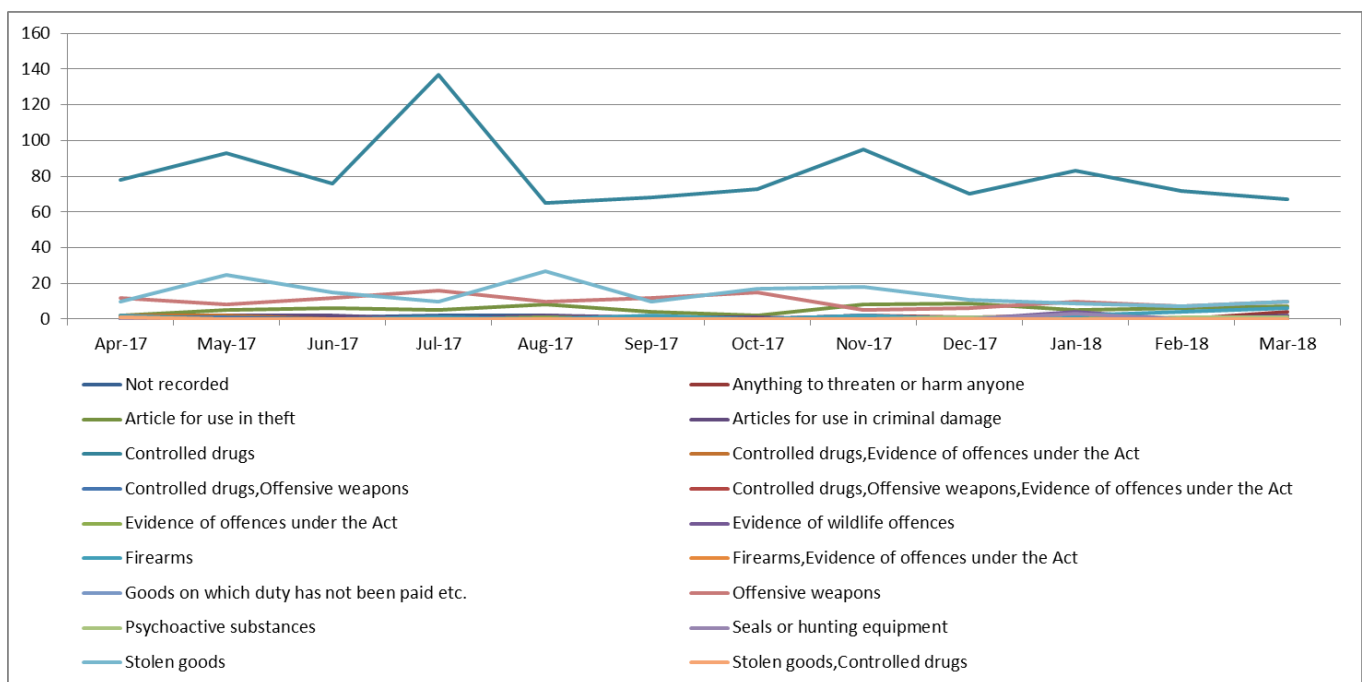


Figure 7: Object of the stop and search – 12 months data

### FORCE

If the proportionality is 1 you have an equal chance of being stopped.

If the proportionality is less than 1 you have less chance of being stopped if you are BME.

If the proportionality is more than 1 you have more chance of being stopped if you are BME.

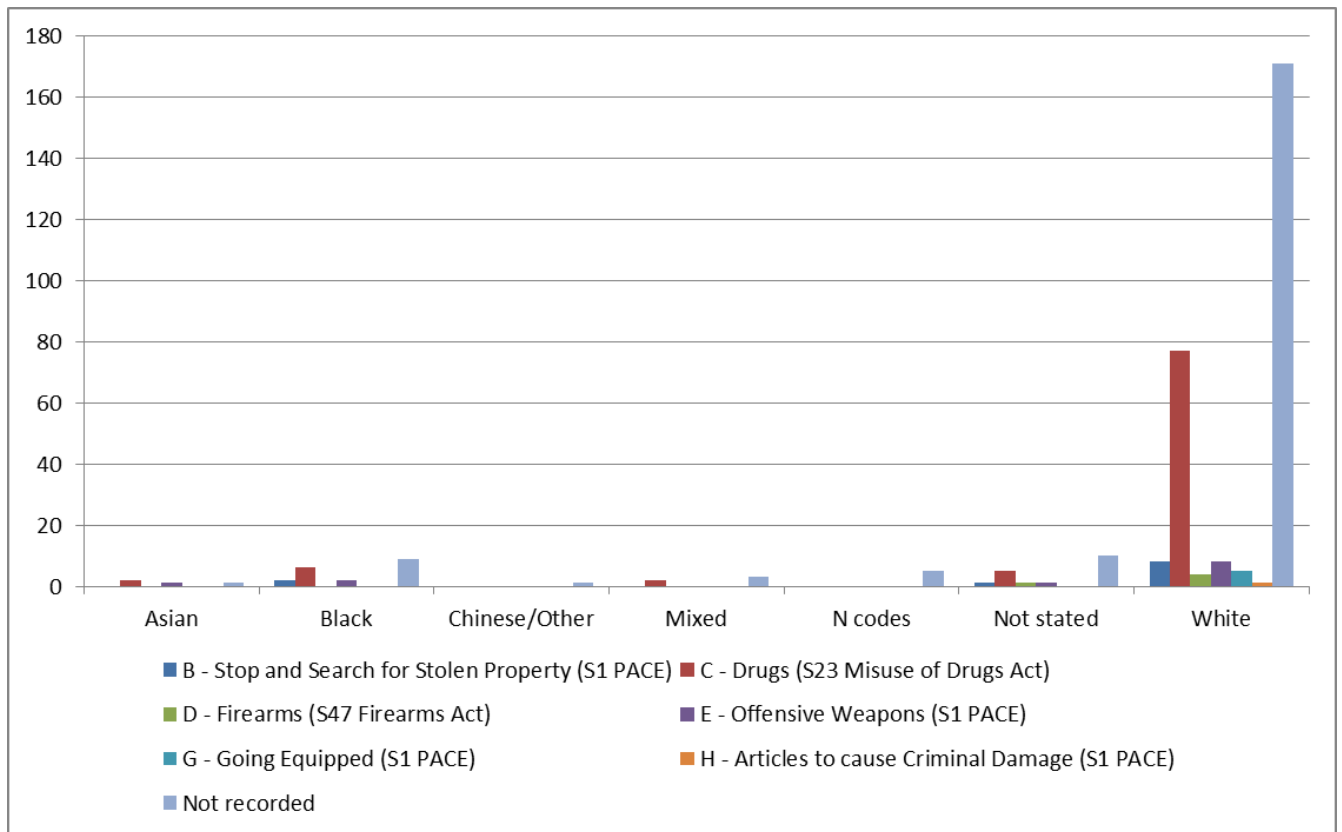


Figure 10: Types of search by ethnicity

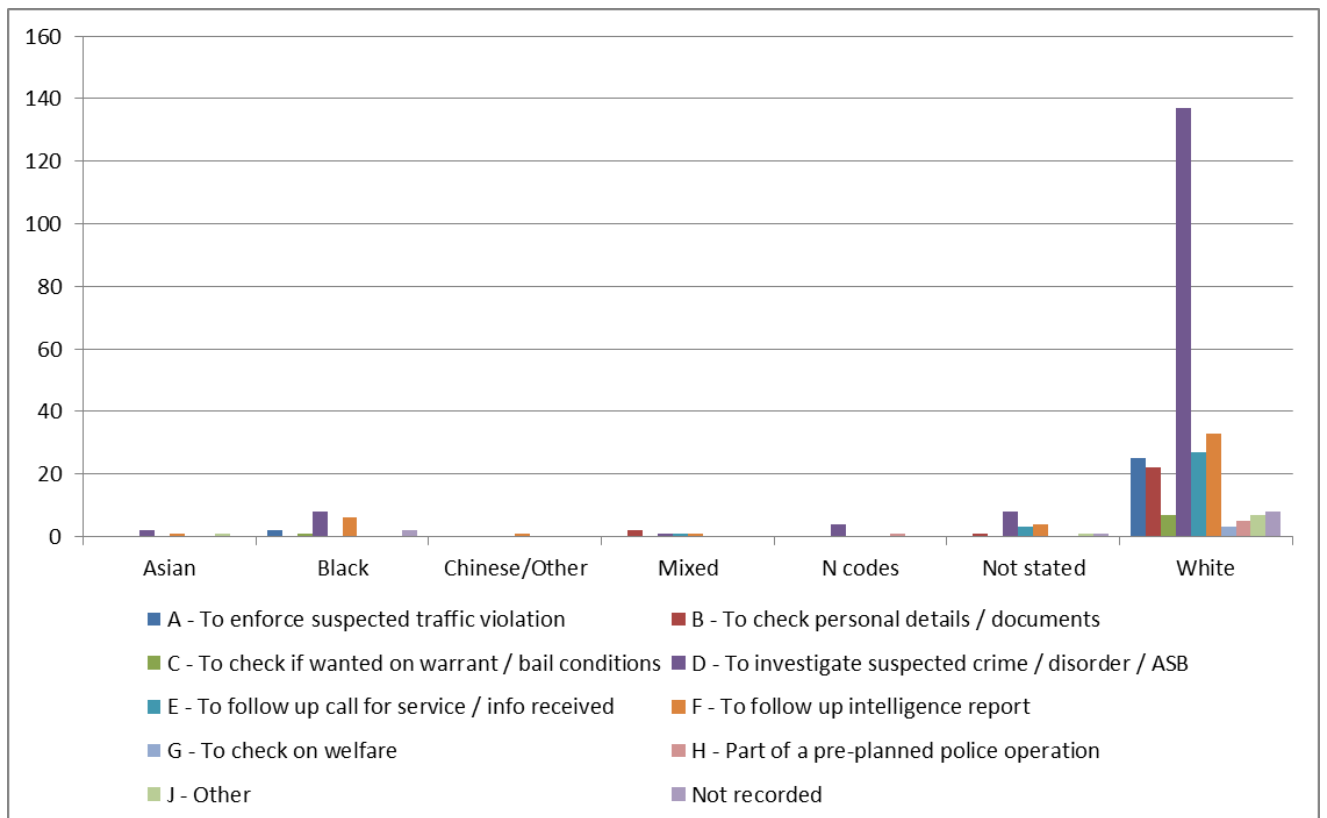


Figure 11: Reasons for stops by ethnicity

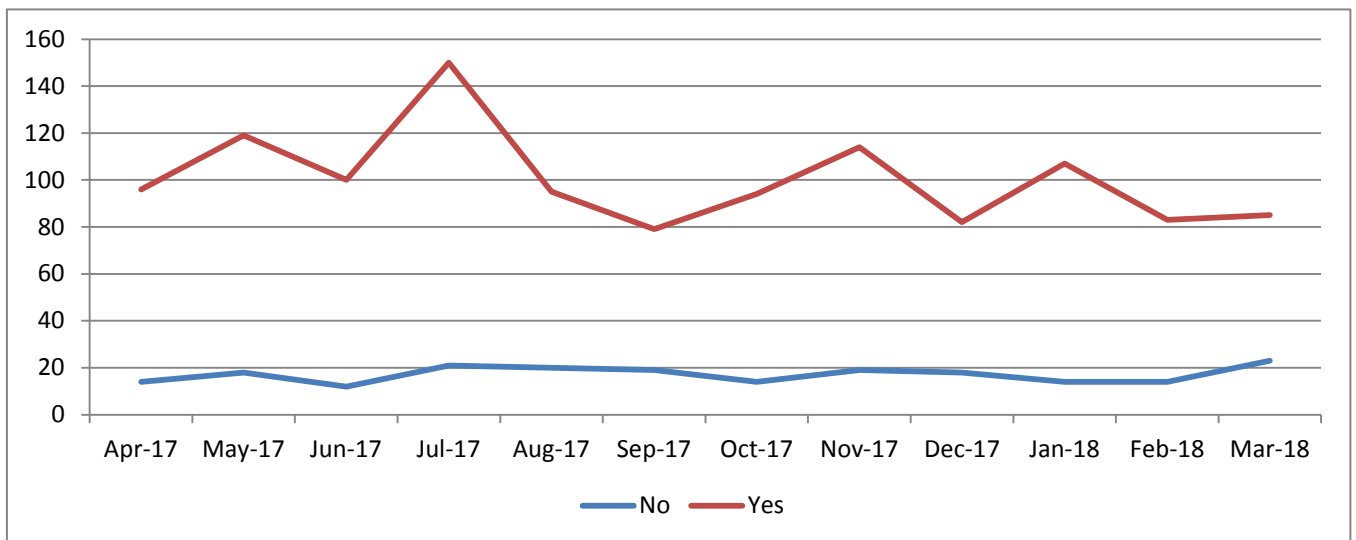

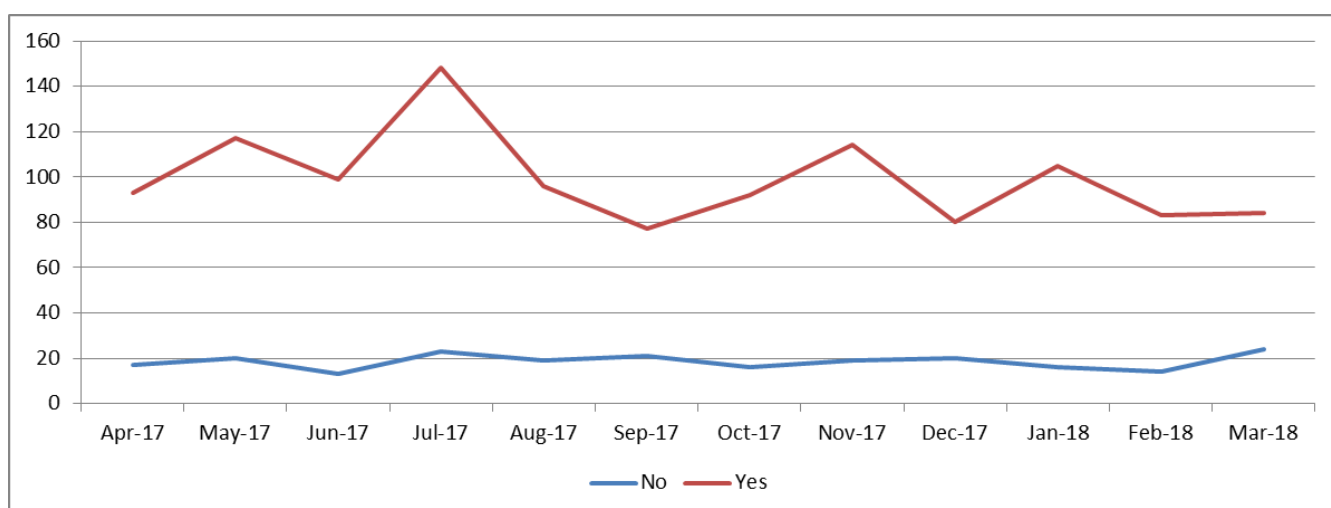


Figure 9: 12 months data for responses to: I was treated professionally, respectfully and with dignity
