A team of Neighbourhood Response Officers covers the Beccles/Bungay area 24 hours a day, seven days a week, dealing with emergencies and serious crime. Phone 999 for emergencies only please.

For non-emergencies or general enquiries please dial 101. You will automatically be put through to Suffolk central call answering centre who will be able to take details of any information, deal with non-emergency enquiries, or put you in contact with someone who can help.

Beccles Police Station is no longer open to the public but there is a phone fixed to the outside wall which is a direct connection to the Suffolk central call answering centre. However, Beccles & Bungay officers and police staff do still work in the station and will continue to use it as a base.

The nearest station that is still open can be found in Old Nelson Street, Lowestoft, NR32 1PE. Lowestoft station opens to the public six days a week, closed on Sundays. Mon-Fri: 9am-5pm, Sat: 10am-6pm.
