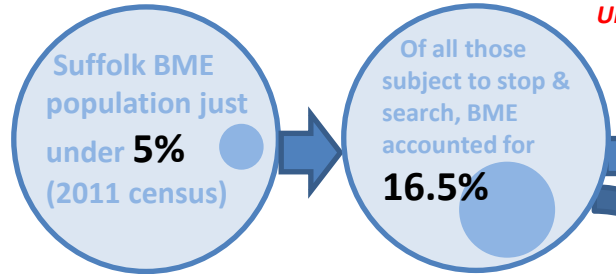


# PROPORTIONALITY OF STOP & SEARCH USE IN SUFFOLK - BME

Date Range 01/04/2017 to 31/03/2018

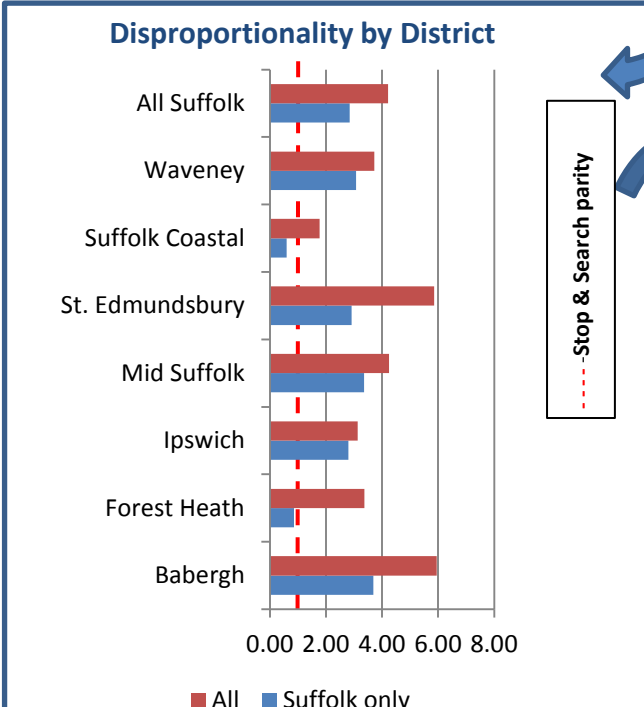

### BME Stop Searches Actioned by Team as % of all BME subjects with a Suffolk address

Ipswich Central Response	13	9.42%
Ipswich East Response	13	9.42%
BSE Response	10	7.25%
Ipswich Central SNT	8	5.80%
Ipswich West Response	8	5.80%

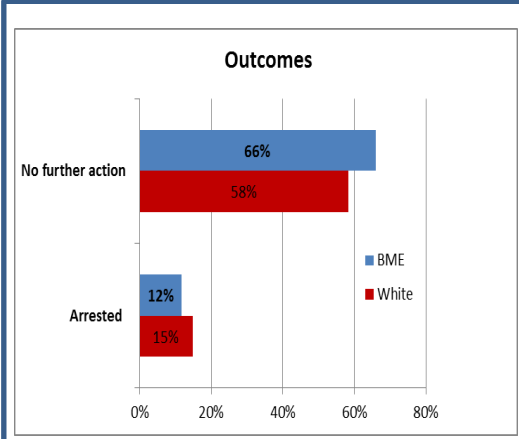
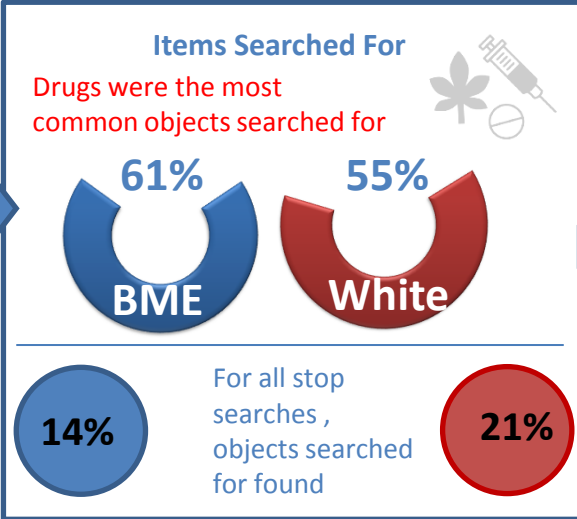
- Disproportionality not able to be calculated at team level due to limitations with census data and policing boundaries.
- C3 database does not show team, so team worked out based on post title of officer, and SNT location of officer actioning the stop search.



- Excluding subjects with addresses outside Suffolk, the local BME community is just under **3** times more likely to be subject of stop/search than white counterparts, increasing to just over **4** times when including all subjects.
- Highest disproportionality seen in **Babergh**.

### Disproportionality amongst under 18s.....

- Amongst Suffolk under 18 population BME = **7%**
- Of all U18s subject to stop search BME = **11.4%**
- Looking at under 18 population, BME subjects **1.8** times more likely to be stop searched than white peers (Suffolk only)



- Following stop search Suffolk's BME population are subject to NFA slightly more often than the White population
- BME subjects are slightly less likely to be arrested than their White counterparts.

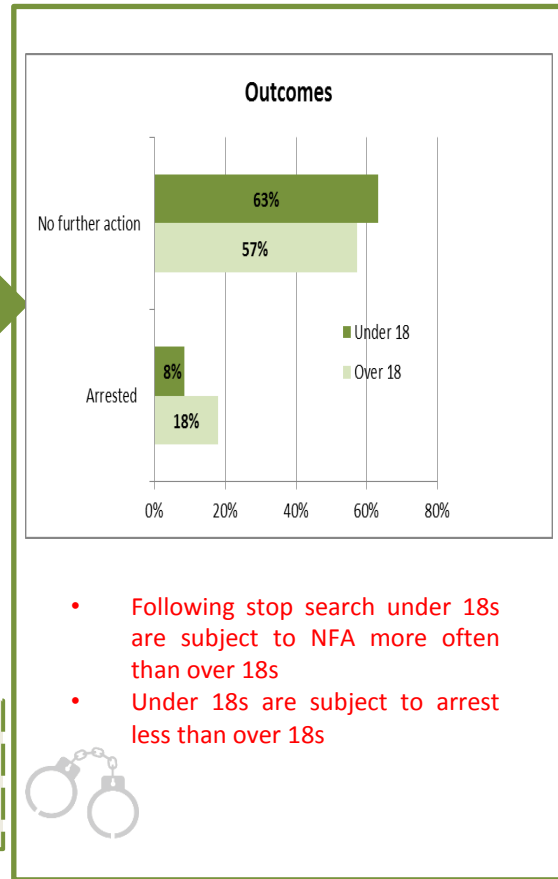
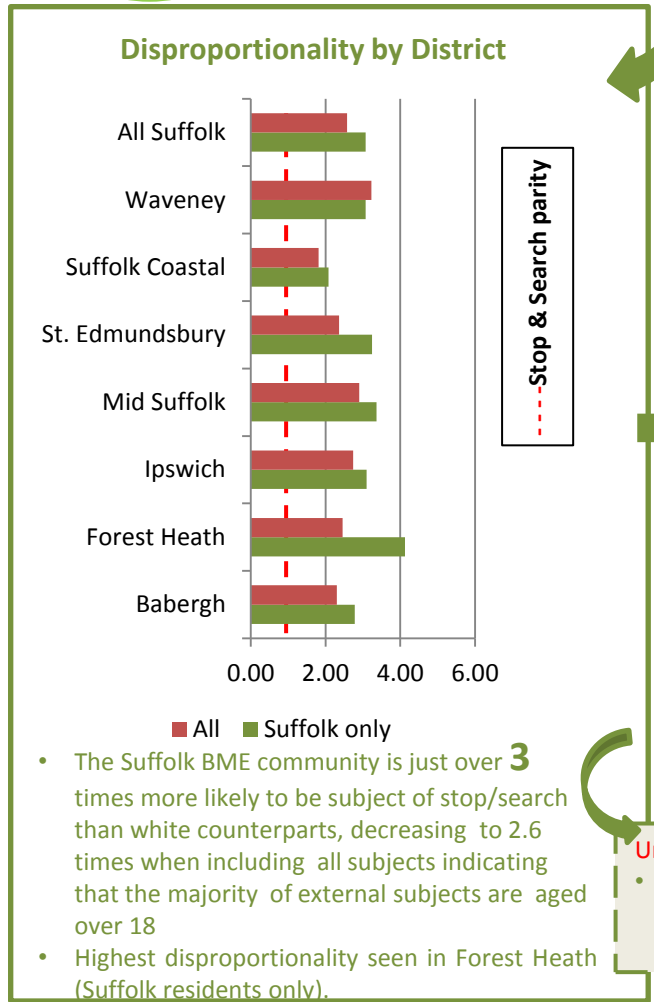
Suffolk Under 18 population just under **10%** (2011 census)

Under 18s accounted for **23.1%** of stop searches

### Under 18 Stop Searches Actioned by Team as % of all U18 Stop Searches with a Suffolk address

Actioning Team	U18 Count	U18 %
BSE Response	23	7.49%
Stowmarket Response	23	7.49%
Ipswich Central Response	21	6.84%
Lowestoft Response	18	5.86%
Haverhill Response	17	5.54%

**Under 18 disproportionality amongst BME.....**

- Looking at Suffolk's BME communities, under 18s are more likely to be subject of stop and search than over 18s at a rate of **1.6**.
