WE DID...

1. We continue to conduct workshops across the locality with the most vulnerable. Educating on crime methods, prevention & reporting around distraction burglaries, personal safety and fraud.
2. We are working closely with the local authority, businesses and schools to address individual issues. We have reduced the level of repeat ASB through action against offenders, target hardening, and the use of Community Protection Notice legislation.
3. We continue to work closely with partners involved in the care of children in need, to identify individual risks and circumstances to reduce exposure, identify offenders and afford protection. This has led to a number of children being identified as no longer being at risk from CSE.

Welcome to our new newsletter which has replaced the old town and parish council reports following the Suffolk local policing review.

Moving forward our priorities and updates will focus more around threat, harm and risk and our four core areas of work. As such you may see a decrease in our reporting of traditional issues such as speeding and parking. This is because we want to keep you updated on the more serious and challenging issues facing our communities.

Local crime information is unavailable at this time as our analytical team are working on an improved search facility to ensure that the figures quoted are accurate. We will keep you posted on the progress for this.

As I explained at the Stowmarket public meeting on Monday 21st March 16, there have been changes to both geographical boundary's and how we work. The SNT specialist roles highlighted above will be carried out alongside regular crime fighting duties that our officers currently perform.
