1. Drugs Offences, Beccles
2. Anti-Social Use of Motor Vehicles in Bungay Town Centre

WE DID...

1. A marked police vehicle on general mobile patrols located a motor vehicle in the forecourt of Tescos Petrol Station. The vehicle was acting suspiciously and was subsequently stopped. A search was then conducted and a large amount of cannabis was located along with cash and mobile phones. Both the driver and passenger was arrested on suspicion of Possession With Intent To Supply. The driver was also further arrested on suspicion of driving with no insurance and also driving a motor vehicle on a road or public place whilst over a specified drug limit.
2. Following a number of reports from concerned members of the public about the manner of driving of vehicles in Bungay town centre, Safer Neighbourhood Team Officers have carried out speed enforcement and issued several fixed penalty notices for excess speed and other moving traffic offences. Enforcement will continue and Officers have noticed an improvement in driving standards already.
