Responding to issues in your community

There were 123 reported crimes, for November, compared with 87 for the same period in 2016.

Following complaints of irresponsible parking during the morning and afternoon School Run. Officers are continually attending to keep the traffic flowing and more importantly the children and parents safe.

Making the community safer

Following a complaint of motorists speeding along the B1062 (Beccles to Bungay) a Speed Detection Recorder (SDR) will be installed by the Safe Cam team to monitor the level of traffic and current speeds.

PCSOs attended 'Crucial Crew' to highlight online safety to Primary School Children in the Waveney area. 1201 pupils were seen over a 10 day period.

PCSOs Wallace and Green were in attendance at a Careers event held at St John Leman High School. They provided advice and information on becoming a Police Officer, Special Constable or becoming a police Staff member.

Following an Indecent Exposure incident in Worlingham a male was arrested then released. Enquiries are still ongoing to identify the suspect.

There was a recent incident of fraudulent £50 notes being circulated in Beccles PCSO's issued Bank of England guidance leaflets to local retailers to heighten awareness.
