Responding to issues in your community

Details of the Police and Crime Commissioner's annual public meeting for Forest Heath have now been confirmed. Mr Passmore will be joined by a senior Police officer and your locality Inspector for this years event which will take place on Thursday 24th May 2018 at the Brandon House Hotel, Brandon. The meeting starts at 7pm with tea and coffee available from 6.40 pm. This is a great opportunity to find out what is happening in your area and to ask any questions you may have.

Making the community safer

Following several calls from members of the public as female was identified as causing ASB around Market Hill and Tescos in Brandon. SNT have since interviewed her and she is awaiting summons to Court, as well as serving her with a Community Protection Notice restricting her behaviour.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

Following a resurgence in ASB at the Brandon Library, the SNT utilised local CCTV and identified those responsible. This led to engagement at local schools and one to one visits to parents/children to discuss the issues. This has led to an almost total reduction in issues and the staff at the Library have been appreciative of the efforts by the team.
