Responding to issues in your community

Welcome to the updated version of our monthly newsletter. Following feedback, it was agreed that a change was needed. It was felt that the crime data was confusing and contained insufficient detail to be of use. As an organisation, we are moving away from crime counting and are instead monitoring exceptions to annual trends. Including both increases and reductions in crime types, thus ensuring that our response to crime trend is measured and proportionate. Making the community safer

Reports of drinking in the area of the Orchard are being reported and police have been carrying out high visibility patrols and engaging with people found. Also a report of a rough sleeper who was causing issues in the Brandon area, this has now been dealt with and the male concerned is currently detained in prison.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

The team have been working very closely with partner agencies to provide somewhere for the young people of Brandon to meet, following numerous complaints of ASB in the vicinity of the Market Square. The Leisure Centre have kindly agreed to allow them a chill out area to meet etc. This has led to a reduction in reports of issues being reported in relation to this group.
