STREET BEGGING IN BURY ST EDMUNDS - YOUR KINDNESS COULD KILL

Police are working with agencies to ensure that individuals have access to housing, health care and appropriate benefits. Unfortunately, there is a core of individuals who refuse to engage with services and continue to aggressively beg. Three arrests have been made this month.

The money the public give to people who are begging is likely to be used to buy the drugs and alcohol that could kill them. Most people sleeping rough do not beg. Most people begging do not sleep rough. If you want to help, put your spare change where it counts. Give money responsibly and support local charities instead. The majority of people who are begging in Bury St Edmunds are not homeless.

NORTHGATE, SOUTHGATE, RISBYGATE, MORTEN HALL, WESTGATE, SOUTHGATE WARDS

There is an ongoing series of linked Burglaries in these wards this year. The offenders are targeting insecure homes overnight and taking cash, electricals and jewelry. Please be extra vigilant in these areas and report any suspicious behavior to the Police. Also, do not make it easy for the criminals and make sure you lock your house securely at night.

STANTON WARD

Ongoing work with housing providers and partner agencies to tackle anti social behaviour issues and crime within the village and surrounding area. The anti social activity has focused on a small number of families and has included criminal damage. All reports of crime and ASB are being investigated and we are working with the well motivated community to address the root causes.

Crime statistics

Suffolk Constabulary are keenly aware that we have not published any crime and event data in April, May and now June. The reasons for this revolve around our ICT system which has not been performing as we would have wanted recently and we cannot currently guarantee the accuracy of the data we might publish. We have therefore made the decision not to publish data at this time rather than publish misleading data and misrepresent the true situation, either positively or negatively. We know this is frustrating for communities. Our ICT team are working very hard to rectify this situation and have given assurances the situation will soon be resolved. Sorting this out is a priority for us and we offer our apologies at this time for the situation. When it is rectified we will be able to publish both current and historic (i.e. April/May + June) data as required. We hope normal service will soon be restored!
