### WE DID...

1. Main culprits have been identified and increased Police patrols are using powers under the DPPO (giving police powers to seize alcohol from people causing ASB). Consideration is being made to take further enforcement action such as Community Protection orders and Criminal Behaviour Orders if the culprits do not stop their behaviour.
2. Community Surveys have been conducted in the area. SNT have been working with the Roads Policing Unit to conduct targeted patrols to catch and deter offenders.

## Halloween Safety

In the run up to Halloween the SNT are working with locals shops and schools to promote a responsible attitude to Halloween, to ensure that it is a happy and safe time for those of all ages.

A number of posters have been designed and will be distributed within the community, encouraging shops not to sell eggs and flour to unaccompanied children in the days prior to Halloween.

Parents are also being urged to consider the safety of their children, through posing questions such as 'if it wasn't Halloween would you let your children knock on strangers doors?' and 'think how you would feel if it were your gran or grandad on the other side of the door. ## GET IN TOUCH

We wanted to remind you of the many ways you can get in touch with us. Most importantly, if it's an emergency always ring 999. However, if it's not an emergency but you wish to report a crime or a concern for safety then use 101. If you simply wish to contact your local team, perhaps to tell us about Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) or a series of crimes occurring in your area, or to tell us about your concerns about how the police have handled a local community matter, why not in the first instance speak with your local Sergeant and discuss the matter with them? Your local Sergeants will be able to review the matter and make an assessment about how well we did, reporting back to you with their findings. Your local community Sergeants are Anna Whybro and Lisa Vaughan. If you want to speak to your local officer and it's not urgent then an email will be quickest means to get in contact, and if you need a reply than a member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs. Remember, the demand on 101 is very high and if you don't need to report a crime we would encourage the use of email.
