RESPOND

The SNT have dedicated extra time to dealing with complaints of illegal parking in Bury St Edmunds in November. Suffolk Constabulary is one of only a few police forces where the enforcement of parking is not dealt with by the local authority. In this month's initiative 374 fixed penalty tickets have been issued around the town, at locations including Angel Hill, where illegally parked cars in the bus bays cause havoc for the buses, and illegal parking in loading bays prevent lorries from making their deliveries to shops.

MAKING YOUR COMMUNITY SAFER

In November the SNT took two cases to court to apply for property 'closure orders' at premises in The Vinefields and Eastgate Street. Residents at both these locations had been greatly suffering from antisocial behaviour and nuisance caused by the occupants allowing their property to be used by drug dealers from out of the area. The courts have fully closed one of these properties, and partially closed the other - preventing no one but the legal tenant to be at the address.

PREVENTING, REDUCING AND SOLVING CRIME AND ASB

There has been a recent spate of thefts from motor vehicles both in the town, and rural areas. Works vans in particular have been targeted, with tools stolen from within and also number plates. Please be vigilant, checking doors and windows are locked, do not leave items on display and remove any tools if possible, try to park in a secure location and consider the use of CCTV on your driveway and register your tools with immobilise.com
