Responding to issues in your community

Police have been dealing with an incident on The Howard Estate Bury St Edmunds involving an assault on a vulnerable woman. Following this members of the SNT have been spending time patrolling the area to offer reassurance to members of the public and discuss their needs and issues. Complaints received regarding speeding in Green Lane Honnington. SNT have requested that the speed van is depolyed in that area. This has resulted in a number of prosecutions.

Making the community safer

Reports of parking and Speeding issues on Oakes Road Bury St Edmunds have resulted in police issuing warnings to drivers and residents who have left their vehicle parked in a dangerous position. this will be followed up by a multi agency approach into solving the issues. Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

Following a burglary at a tool hire centre in Bury St Edmunds officers have been offering crime prevention advice on industrial estates in the town as well as the rural area to help prevent other businesses being a victim of crime. This will continue over the coming month. SNT officers have been looking at parking issues in the town centre and 120 fixed penalty notices have been issued.
