#### Door Locks

It is essential that you fit the correct locks to your doors. The type of lock you need will depend on the type of door. The following is a brief guide as to what you should look for.

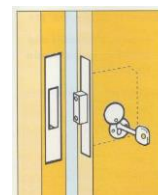
All locks recommended by the police should meet BS3621 or TS007 Standard and carry the British Standard Institute Kite Mark.

#### 1. Solid Front door.

Fit a 5 lever BS Mortice Deadlock.

Fit bolts to top and bottom of door.

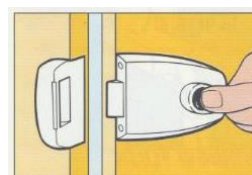
Fit door viewer and security chain for extra protection.

#### 2. Half/full glass Front door.

Fit deadlocking rim latch

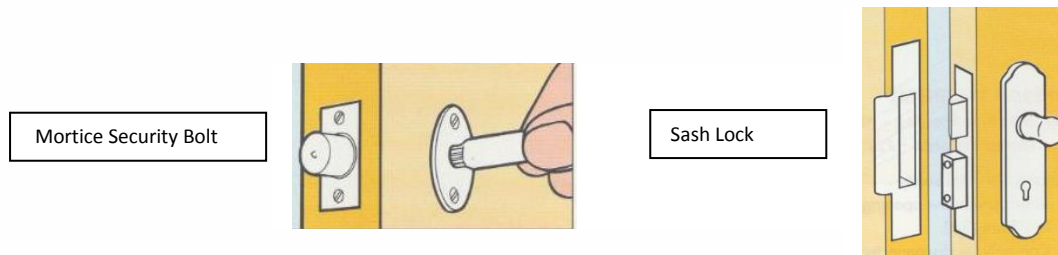

Fit bolts top/bottom of door

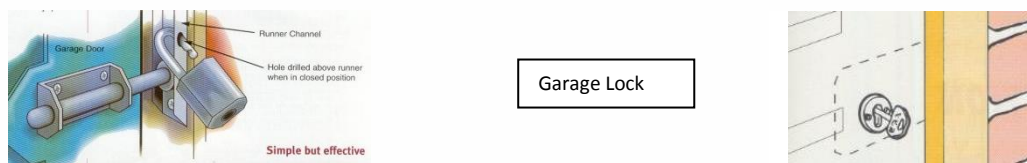
### Rear/side door.

Fit a 5 lever Sash lock, adding Mortice security bolts top/bottom for extra security.



### 4. Garage door

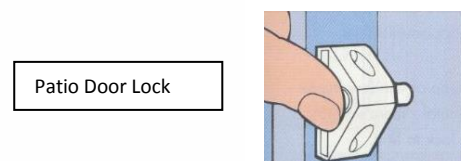
Fit a garage door lock both sides or padlock on internal runner.



### 5. French windows/Patio doors

Fit Mortice security bolts top and bottom of each leaf on French doors.

Fit patio door locks to top and bottom of sliding patio doors to prevent lifting and sliding.



### 6. Doors where hinges are exposed.

Consider fitting hinge bolts as extra security in case hinges are attacked.
