On the 23rd of July, Eye SNT supported by colleagues from Halesworth & Bury St. Edmunds attended the C.K. Meats factory site on the Mid-Suffolk Business park to police protesters and deliveries to the site. This is a monthly commitment and usually passes peacefully. Protesters monitor the transport conditions of animals to ensure compliance with relevant legislation.
