FURTHER INFORMATION

We have continued to deal with the issues of speeding in our towns and villages, such as Palgrave, Yaxley, Stuston and Brome with enforcement by the Safe Cam Team, SNT officers and the Special Constabulary who not only enforce but also educate drivers about the consequences of speed.

The team have also been dealing with parking issues across the area ensuring that the roads are free from unnecessary obstructions keeping them safe for pedestrians and road users.

The SNT has been working in partnership with Junior Road Safety Officers in local schools on speed awareness, illegal and inconsiderate parking and the "hands off mobile phone campaign"


We have, along with response officers, been dealing with Anti Social Behaviour issues in Eye and Stradbroke through targeted patrols and working closely with the residents that are affected by ASB. We have been able to identify the persons responsible and taken appropriate action. We will continue to monitor ASB in the area.

The team have carried out a number of licensed premises checks to ensure that landlords are complying with the terms of their licenses. We will continue to work with the licensed premises to reduce underage drinking, pub related ASB and drink driving.

Further demonstrations took place at Halal foods (also known locally as Two Sisters) and C & K Meats. These were peaceful events with all parties concerned, including Suffolk Police, engaging with each other. Pc 1544 Andrews-Pearce continues to play an active role.

Join Police Connect

Police Connect is a messaging service connecting you to the very latest policing news for your area via e-mail, text or phone. There is no charge for this service - all messages you receive are free.

You can register to receive information about the issues that matter most to you and be among the first to be alerted by police in the case of an emergency affecting your area. You can choose to receive regular updates on crime and public appeals, safety advice and meetings and events. There is the option to receive information about a range of specific interest areas – such as 'rural' or 'rivers and coastal' – as well as updates for business owners and news from your Police and Crime Commissioner. The choice is yours.

How to register

The simple online process takes only a couple of minutes and will ensure we have the most up-to-date contact details and preferences for you. Just go to the Suffolk Police Web page and follow the link on the left hand side.

Crime Prevention Advice

We are reminding vehicle owners to make sure their vehicles are left locked when they are parked whether that is in public or within private grounds. Please also make sure that you do not leave any valuables on show which would attract the attention of anyone wishing to steal. If you do wish to discuss crime prevention advice or find out more about how you can mark your property then please contact the local SNT team.

Raising Community concerns

There are a number of ways you can get in touch with Suffolk Constabulary depending on the urgency and type of request. By telephone in an emergency always dial 999. Dialing 999 is a must if you are facing an incident or crime right now and you need police help immediately.

The Suffolk Constabulary non-emergency number 101 is the number to call when you want to contact police when it is less urgent than 999.

The non-emergency number is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Alternatively you can report a crime online.

If you want to speak to your local Safer Neighbourhood Team and it's not urgent using email will be quickest and if you want any member of the team they will get back to you within 24hrs. The SNT email address is: eye.snt@suffolk.pnn.police.uk

If you have an issue with how the police have handled a local community matter, such as dealing with an incident of ASB, or if you have an issue relating to something like a series of crimes occurring in your area, we advise that you speak to your locality Inspector Mark Jackson, to highlight your concerns. Inspector Jackson will be able to review the circumstances of the incident/matter and our response and make an assessment about how it is handled.
