FURTHER INFORMATION

During the month of June 2016 Felixstowe had 236 recorded investigations : (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into safeguarding individuals).

Among the investigations were three domestic burglaries where entry was gained either through open windows or insecure integral garage doors. The property stolen were small portable items such as mobile phones and tablets. The windows had been left open during the humid spell but please be conscious of the potential for opportunist thieves.

There were two victims of robbery when on both occasions a loan male was accosted by the suspect who made verbal threats before stealing cash and a watch. The suspect has been arrested and charged with these crimes having been identified by witnesses.

There were a number of victims who had baggage stolen that had been left insecure in a rear garden.

Nacton and Purdis Farm had 16 recorded investigations:

4 of these related to theft from shops and all suspects have been identified and dealt with by fixed penalty tickets or Community Resolutions.

2 were thefts from lorry cabs at the Orwell truck stop

1 damage to a toilet block door at a local camping site

Other investigations:

Road rage incident where motorists entered into an abusive dispute over the manner of driving.


Child Protection Investigation x 3

Kirton had six recorded offences.

One of these related to the theft of a motor vehicle where a suspect is currently on Police bail.

FURTHER INFORMATION

The Trimleys had 25 recorded investigations:

There were three recorded domestic Burglaries, one of these was at a local public house where entry was gained through a first floor window. Another burglary was where a suspect attempted to force a rear door however no entry was gained.

One offence of Arson where a derelict barn had been set alight- police are interviewing a number of suspects

2 crimes of theft from motor vehicles on the same evening, both had been insecure.

3 offences of damage to motor vehicles where offender had scratched body panels with a sharp instrument.
