FURTHER INFORMATION

During the month of June 2016 Felixstowe had 176 recorded investigations : (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into safeguarding individuals).

We investigated 22 assault allegations, five of those being serious assault allegations, four of which were alcohol fueled and offenders are being dealt with.

There was one robbery from a female walking alone in the early hours of the morning following a night out drinking, a mobile phone was stolen. Police urge people to stay in groups when out on the town and if this is not possible then arrange for a lift or get a taxi.

There was one theft from person with a mobile phone being stolen whilst playing arcade games. Please keep personal possessions secure at all times.

We had two arson related incidents this month, one involved a rubbish bag in a garden being set alight and the other where a small area of undergrowth was set alight. Local youths are believed to be responsible for this and it is being looked into.

There was one burglary of a home where force was used to enter a premises and items stolen from within. If you are planning to go on holiday it is a good idea to set lights on timers and if possible give a trusted person a key to check the property and remove any post from the door mat.

Two vehicles were broken into where personal possessions were on display. Police ask that you remove all personal possessions from vehicles and leave secure when you are not with it. It is a good idea to rub away the 'tell tale' sucker mark on the windscreen left by your satnav device so as not to encourage offenders to break into the vehicle to see if the device has been left in the glove compartment or under a seat.

One person was arrested and dealt with for possession of an offensive weapon.

Enforcement action has continued this month in relation to drugs offences, one person has been charged and three are on bail for possession of a Class 'A' Drug. Two people were given warnings for possession of a Class 'B' Drug (Cannabis). This enforcement will continue into next month.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Nacton and Purdis Farm had 17 recorded investigations:

There was one Burglary of a home where a property was entered via an insecure window and items stolen from within. A possible known suspect is being investigated. Whenever you leave your home always make sure you secure all windows and doors and do not leave a spare key where someone may be likely to find it.

Six Theft (from shop) incidents which relate to Sainburys and Homebase. One offender given a Fixed Penalty Notice and two others arrested, charged and remanded in custody to attend court.
