WE DID...

1. We have targeted areas associated with drug dealing resulting in seven seizures of personal amounts of class A and B drugs including a cultivation offence. We have executed warrants and stopped vehicles and persons associated with dealing Class A drugs. Further arrests include one male who has been remanded in custody for possession with intent to supply class A and B drugs.
2. Patrols have been increased and targeted at the Martello park area and the Victorian Shelters. Reports had been received about noisy vehicles, of which we have had four vehicles identified and the registered owners have been sent warning letters regarding this. Since then complaints regarding noisy vehicles have lessened.

FURTHER INFORMATION

During the month of January 2017 the Felixstowe SNT area had 224 recorded investigations: (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into safeguarding individuals).

Felixstowe East Ward had 11 investigations.

These included 2 burglary dwellings, one in Cliff Road where rear window was smashed with a brick to gain access whilst the owners away, an untidy search in multiple rooms. Another was in Lodge Farm Drive where access was gained and jewellery stolen.

Felixstowe North Ward had 56 investigations.

Damage was caused to a dwelling on High Road West by breaking a rear door window outer pane.

Burglary dwelling on Beatrice Avenue where rear patio door smashed to gain access and untidy search made within.

Theft of charity box from a public house on the High Street linked to several other similar offences across rural areas. A suspect has been charged.

Felixstowe South Ward had 60 investigations.

Damages and interference with motor vehicles recorded in Manning Road, Leopold Road, Langer Road, Sea Road and two vehicles scratched on Cowley Road.

Suspect detained and charged with theft from supermarket on Langer Road.

Suspect detained for drunk and disorderly on Bent Hill, subsequently found in possession of Class A drugs.

Damage caused to Art Gallery window on Bent Hill, suspect currently on bail as investigation continues.

Burglary dwelling on Manwick Road where front door window pane forced and removed hi-fi system, CD's and Blue tooth speaker from within.

One burglary and another attempted burglary of two charity shops on Hamilton Road. A rear window was forced and damaged on one but no access gained. The other was accessed via rear toilet window, untidy search made within resulting in cash, the till float and petty cash etc. stolen.

Felixstowe West Ward had 63 investigations.

These included an attempted burglary dwelling in Long Field whereby a UVPC window was forced with a jemmy and broken but no access gained.

Possession of cannabis with intent to supply, a group of youths found in children's play area near to Grange Primary School, upon search suspect found to have quantity of cannabis and drug paraphernalia. Investigation remains ongoing.


In a further investigation police have dealt with a suspect for an offence of cultivating Cannabis at an address in Runnacles Way.

A vehicle was stop checked in Mill Close and the two occupants were dealt with for possession with intent to supply class A. A substantial amount of crack cocaine and heroin were seized including a large amount of money and enquiries are continuing.

FURTHER INFORMATION

In the Kirton Ward there were 11 investigations.

There was the burglary of an insecure shed of a property off Tenth Road, Bucklesham removing a chainsaw and ride on lawnmower.

Possession of controlled drug-Cocaine, male suspect found nearby vehicle in ditch off A14 Levington and found to have drug in his possession, the investigation is continuing.

On the A14 Bucklesham, a lorry had the curtain side cut and a substantial amount of clothing removed from within.

Nacton and Purdis Heath had 24 investigations.

Six investigations relate to theft from Supermarket at Purdis.

Secure building site office off Straight Road broken into removing keys from within. Storage containers opened and tools removed including two Stihl disc cutters, Makita impact driver and two Paslode fix guns. Police stop checked a vehicle Felixstowe Road whereby the passenger was found to be in possession of Cannabis. Police are still investigating.

The Trimleys had 24 investigations during January.

Burglary of farm outbuilding off Thorpe Lane by removal of padlock and taken a strimmer and toolbox from within.

Attempted burglary dwelling of property on Jasmine Close, front door had jemmy marks and lock was loose but no access gained.

Theft of cheese from shop on High Road by suspect previously banned. Police are still investigating.

Criminal damage to a motor vehicle on Brotherton Avenue by smashing rear side window, nothing was taken from within.
