## WE DID...

1. Police continue to patrol and respond to reported ASB incidents along the sea front. Work is continuing with Youth agencies to look at providing a mobile facility to allow support services to engage.
2. Repeated calls from the Snowhill area of males causing noise and disturbance sitting on a bench at that location. Officers have attended and advised individuals located in that area and dispersed them when appropriate. SCDC making plans to remove the bench from its current location.
3. Numerous reports of trespassing in a large disused office block adjacent to the docks. Work in progress to ensure current tenants secure access effectively.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

During the month of April 2017 the Felixstowe SNT area had 347 recorded investigations: (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also investigations into safeguarding individuals).

Felixstowe East Ward had 5 investigations.

Overnight on the 28th fuel was stolen from a storage tank in Bawdsey Close. This is not the first time this is believed to have happened over recent months.

Felixstowe North Ward had 65 investigations.

These included 2 incidents of making off without payment of fuel from a service station in the High Road. Police have arrested a suspect for these and other non related incidents linked to the same individual.

Over the Easter weekend offenders smashed a double glazed door gaining access to a property in Dellwood Avenue and stole cash and jewellery.

A padlock was bolt cropped off from a storage container at the Felixstowe Academy over the weekend of 7th-10th.

Sports equipment was scattered around the location but nothing appears stolen. offenders potentially looking for mowers and garden equipment.

Overnight on the 24th of April, a garden workshop in Maidstone Road was entered and £400 of power tools were stolen.

Felixstowe South Ward had 91 investigations.

In early April Police attended an incident in Burgate Road and arrested and charged a male for criminal damage and an assault.

A number of ASB reports have been taken in the area of Snowhill off Undercliff Road involving males drinking alcohol and causing disturbance to nearby residents. These issues have previously been reported over a period of time and this has become a priority at the Tasking meeting held at the end of April.

There were two pedal cycles stolen from the Cycle racks next to Tesco supermarket in the town center during the evening of the 3rd of April. Offenders cut through a cable lock that was securing them to the rack. On the 5th of April insecure cycles were removed from a residential home further down Cobbold Road. There were two further reports of insecure cycle thefts later in the month in UnderCliff Road.

A number of cars parked in roads in the South Ward were scratched overnight on Thursday 13th of April. Police believe this was caused by a loan male walking along the middle of the road using a sharp instrument, randomly scratching car panels resulting in thousands of pounds worth of damage. The cars were parked in roads including Tacon Road, Russell Road and St Edmunds Road.

On Sunday the 23rd there were a series of incidents resulting in Police pursuing a suspect from the outskirts of Ipswich, through the Trimleys and into Felixstowe. The suspect was located at an address in Walton and has been charged with a number of offenses including assault and dangerous driving.

Felixstowe West Ward had 53 investigations.

On the 3rd of April Police attended an incident at an address in Stour Avenue following a report of a disturbance. A male at the scene was arrested after assaulting two Constables and was subsequently charged with offences.


There was a report of a burglary in Mill Lane Felixstowe during the day on Monday the 10th. The victim came home finding a double glazed front door window had been smashed and a significant value of jewellery stolen.

Alloy wheels were stolen from a Vauxhall Astra parked on a driveway in Coronation Drive overnight on the 27th of April.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

In the Kirton Ward there were 15 investigations.

Overnight in early April, a farm building in Lower Road was entered and the ignition was tampered with on a Suzuki Quad bike.

A landrover has been stolen in the early hours of the 7th of April from a farm in Bucklesham. the stolen vehicle triggered the speed cameras over the Orwell bridge soon afterwards.

A cafe in Kirton had the doors forced open overnight on the 9th and the offenders made an untidy search however nothing appeared to have been stolen.

Nacton and Purdis Farm had a total of 26 Investigations

Over the weekend in early April, a garage was entered in Finneys Drift, Nacton, however nothing appears to have been stolen.

A ride on John Deere tractor lawnmower was stolen from an insecure outbuilding in Bucklesham Road, Nacton. It appeared to have been pushed to a nearby location next to the archery range next to the Suffolk show ground. The offenders have possibly then loaded it on to a vehicle before making off. The second time this has happened.

There were 4 separate investigations recorded at Sainsburys petrol station where the suspects have failed to pay for fuel.

Police are dealing with a suspect for an assault and public order offence at the same location.

The Trimleys had 19 investigations during April.

Overnight on the 10th, a container housing power tools was broken into on a building site in Trimley St Martin.

Overnight on the 24th in Cordys Lane a garage roller door was forced and entry gained where a ride on lawn mower was stolen.
