Responding to issues in your community

During the month of July there were a total of 287 investigations (these relate not only to recorded criminal offences but also safeguarding individuals). These include burglaries, a number of assault allegations where the offender was known to the victim, criminal damage and ASB. There were also a few incidents where quality high value bicycles have been stolen from garages or being left insecure in public places.

Making the community safer

Speeding vehicles is a common concern across each ward area of the Safer Neighborhood Team. To address this a Community Speed Watch group was formed with volunteers trained to conduct speed checks in identified areas to raise awareness and to deter the motorists responsible. Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

Working with local authority contractors, a bench was removed from Snow Hill Walk in Felixstowe where a group of males were congregating and causing a disturbance to local residents. Officers engaged and dispersed those concerned and the ASB incidents have ceased. Local youth services have received funding to use a mobile facility to engage with young people in areas of the Sea front of Felixstowe that have been subject to ASB and vandalism.
