Responding to issues in your community

During the month of September 2018 there was a total of 256 investigations in the Felixstowe and District. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Criminal Offences recorded range from various assaults and public order offences to theft and burglary and drug possession.

Making the community safer

17/09/2018 Male arrested for a number of Thefts from the CO-OP King Street and High Street Felixstowe. Male interviewed and charged to court.

19/09/2018 Male stop searched Nacton and found in possession of herbal cannabis. He was issued with a Cannabis Caution.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

01/09/2018 Attempt Burglary of Business Premises Bucklesham where roller door of garage was forced and damaged. No items were disturbed or damaged.

02/09/2018 Theft of mobile phone from back pocket a victim was walking along Felixstowe Pomenade.

05/09/2018 Theft from Motor Vehicle Mill Road Purdis Farm Ipswich. Overnight entry gained via the boot and bank cards stolen.

16/09/2018 Burglary Dwelling Trimley St Martin. Entry gained to detached house via insecure window. Cash and and car keys stolen. Grey Volkswagen Golf stolen off driveway.
