Responding to issues in your community

The SNT receive a lot of complaints of speeding in the villages and the second speeding day of action was carried out on 30th November 2017. This was again very successful with a total of 54 people being caught speeding by the Safety camera Van team and 4 tickets for speeding issued by the SNT. The team continually monitor reports of speeding and work closely with the Safety Camera Team to ensure the correct locations are identified for enforcement.

There have been a number of house burglaries reported to police in the past month including Capel St Mary, Nayland and Stratford St Mary.

Making the community safer

The Hadleigh SNT team have been working closely with the high schools in the area due to a spate of young people sharing inappropriate comments and photos on social media. Lessons and assemblies have been completed in the schools to ensure the youths are fully aware of the consequences of their actions and also what to do if they find themselves being bullied.

Regular patrols in our villages have been increased to provide a high visual profile due to the amount of burglary's in the villages.

Please report anything suspicious as we would much rather attend a false alarm than a real burglary. You are our eyes and ears when we are not in the area.

Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

The new landowner of the land surrounding Bobbits Lane, Ipswich which is being used by off road motorcycles is working with Hadleigh SNT officers to prevent this anti social behavior occurring. Uniform patrols have been carried out in the area and motorcyclist spoken to, advised and educated. By having this positive approach the problems have decreased.
