Within Sudbury and Hadleigh we are currently seeking CCTV Volunteers - As you may know, Sudbury and Hadleigh town centre's CCTV system is monitored by volunteers from Sudbury Police Station and they play an important part in keeping the community safe. There are a number of ways you can get in touch with Suffolk Constabulary depending on the urgency and type of request. By telephone in an emergency always dial 999. Dialing 999 is a must if you are facing an incident or crime right now and you need police help immediately.

The Suffolk Constabulary non-emergency number 101 is the number to call when you want to contact police when it is less urgent than 999. The non-emergency number is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Alternatively you can report a crime Online.

If you want to speak to your local Safer Neighbourhood Team and it's not urgent using email will be quickest and if you want any member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs. The SNT email address is [Hadleigh.snt@suffolk.pnn.police.uk](mailto:Hadleigh.snt@suffolk.pnn.police.uk).

If you have an issue with how the police have handled a local community matter, such as dealing with an incident of ASB, or if you have an issue relating to something like a series of crimes occurring in your area, we advise that you speak to your locality Inspector, Inspector Kevin Horton, to highlight your concerns and discuss the matter with them. Inspector Horton will be able to review the circumstances of the incident/matter and our response and make an assessment about how it is handled.
