Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

Many of you will have seen myself and some of my team at the Hadleigh show on the 21st May and had the opportunity to discuss any issues you had or to simply learn a little about what we do and how we do it. If you were not one of the 400 odd people who asked then No! we do not really use the tractor for police work. The tractor is merely a show vehicle and is not even owned by the constabulary it is owned and on loan to us for free by CLAAS whom we would like to thank.

In addition to the show I was also at the parish forum this month on the 25th May where again those present were able to raise any police related issues with me. It was also an opportunity to discuss the achievements of my team and the work they had accomplished to address problems over the previous month as well as for the community to give me information to help me decide the areas I wish to direct my resources to in the 2 months ahead.

As well as the work highlighted above my team have continued to work with schools to address problems both in and outside school premises including issues of bullying and harassment in school and across social media, being on school property outside school hours which is an offence for which you can be arrested and parking complaints. They have also continued to work with vulnerable persons in the area and worked with partner agencies to solve a number of community issues.

You will notice that again there is no crime data above and I have been advised that due to a number of internal issues we are unlikely to obtain this before August however as soon as it is available we will publish it. In the meantime data is still available to you via the Police.Com website. I would also encourage interested persons to sign up to Police Connect which will provide information via text message more frequently.
