WE DID...

A professionals meeting was held to discuss issues around land on Paper Mill Lane - Bramford. Immediate concerns were discussed and a long term plan was proposed which is being progressed to address all the concerns raised.

Also other issues concerning ASB were addressed by a key instigator of the problems being arrested and significant work is ongoing to obtain a criminal behavior order to combat the problems long term.

Increased patrols in the area. Key persons involved visited and spoken to. 1 person dealt with for possession of cannabis in the area. The location will remain as a target area to monitor improvement.

Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

On Wednesday 28th September I attended the Parish Forum with Inspector Horton who had come along to get a feel for how the new model was working. We were both pleased that it had been noted by the panel and persons present that there were very few problems or concerns raised anywhere in the locality. This is a stark contrast to a number of years ago when I struggled to identify the team priorities as there were too many competing concerns.

As well as the work highlighted above we have continued to concentrate resources on identifying key persons in the area who have a significant negative impact on their communities either directly or due to the drain on emergency service resources. Having done so extensive work has been conducted in order to reduce this demand and/or find a solution to end the problems they are causing. This work will continue as new issues arise.

Speeding and parking issues have also been addressed with days of action throughout the month targeting offenders and issuing penalty notices to those found.

During the week commencing Monday 26th September all the SNT officers in the Southern area were pooled to intensely target areas of ASB and crime across the sector. The returns for this are currently being collated and I hope to be able to publish the results next month.
