This meeting is a valuable opportunity to discuss community safety matters in the Hadleigh area, network with representatives from adjacent villages and the information provided is then used when deciding on the team priorities.

Pinewood Community Engagement event - Wednesday 19th April 2017 10:00-13:00 at Pinewood Community Hall car park- This will be an opportunity for residents and people in the local area to come and meet the team and discuss any issues/concerns they may have. FURTHER INFORMATION

Welcome to the Hadleigh SNT.

During March the SNT have dealt with a number of reports of anti social behaviour across the area and we are in the process of arranging a specific operation to try and address this. A member of the team is currently dealing with a group of four youths in the Stoke By Nayland area who will be taking part in restorative justice by completing a litter pick at the request of the victim.

The SNT have now held their first community engagement in Shotley and it was great to see so many residents coming to speak with us. We have also held another event at Hollowtrees Farm, Semer and again spoke with lots of local people and other members of the public visiting the area. The next event will be in Pinewood on Wednesday 19th April between 10:00 and 13:00. This is an opportunity for residents and other local people to speak to the team about any concerns or issues that they may have. There will be further events planned at other locations so please watch this space to see when the team will be coming to your area.

There have been a number of positive results which have been posted on the Constabulary social media accounts but will provide a quick summary in case this has been missed;

Operation Fireside – Burglary other buildings around East Ipswich and Shotley. A dedicated Detective Inspector has been appointed to oversee this, two people have been arrested, one warrant executed for stolen goods and enquiries are ongoing.

House burglaries in Bentley – James Preston given a 10 year prison sentence

One person charged for burglary dwelling and burglary other building in Holbrook. Male admitted these two offences and has been sentenced at court.

Series of ram raids on 8th Feb including Hadleigh and Capel – one person has been arrested and is on bail, two others are being sought

ASB in Hadleigh including criminal damage and burglary – four young people have been dealt with and referred to the youth offending service

One person on bail for the Pinewood burglaries waiting for a charging decision from the Crown Prosecution Service.

Male arrested on 03/04/17 in Hadleigh for possession of Cannabis with intent to supply and currently on court bail until 04/05/17.

If you would like to view crimes which may be happening in your area then these figures are available through the Suffolk Constabulary website or Police.uk.

The Safer Neighbourhood team are still working with the district council to try and resolve ASB problems between residents. These incidents have had a negative impact on the community and are a significant demand on police resources. The team are also constantly reviewing and trying to develop intelligence in order to obtain warrants from the court.

I would be keen to hear from any members of the community with any police related issues which they wish to discuss and will be attending the next Parish Forum meeting on 10th May along with Inspector Horton. This is the annual parish forum and we will be delivering a powerpoint presentation with an overview of the past year.
