As always as well as the official crime figures for the November period detailed above I have also included below an overview of the crime reports during December.

You will see that there was a significant rise in burglaries which is always the case before Christmas. This is one of the main reasons we push the safety messages every year and divert resources from our proactive teams and CID investigations into this area of work. This year has been no exception and we have a number of operations that are still being analysed and investigated in an attempt to identify and arrest any persons responsible.

Beyond this my team has been working with a number of agencies such as the Maritime & Coastguard agency, RSPCA and the local councils to address and investigate issues and offences in the area. We have also continued to work with various departments to put in place safeguarding for vulnerable people within the community.

Speeding and parking issues have also been addressed with days of action throughout the month targeting offenders and issuing penalty notices to those found.
