At the time of writing Halloween has been and gone with only 1 Halloween related call to police in the entire Hadleigh sector which is by far the most successful and peaceful year we have ever had. Fireworks night will also have occurred by the time this has been published however at this time I can hope that it will be as uneventful and that everyone acts appropriately so that it can be enjoyed by all.

As highlighted above the Police and Crime Commissioner and the Chief Constable will be in Hadleigh on the 21st November and would welcome views from the public.

As well as the work highlighted above we have continued to concentrate resources on identifying key persons in the area who have a significant negative impact on their communities either directly or due to the drain on emergency service resources. Having done so extensive work has been conducted in order to reduce this demand and/or find a solution to end the problems they are causing. We have already resolved a number of long term problems and put in place community protection notices and other restraining orders to protect individuals and/or communities.

Speeding and parking issues have also been addressed with days of action throughout the month targeting offenders and issuing penalty notices to those found.
