1. Tackle the drug dealers and users in Haverhill.

WE DID...

1. Long term priority for Haverhill. Supported by specialist staff from around the county, Since last newsletter, two further drug warrants have been executed. Three more arrests made. Quantity of drugs have been seized. One man charged and remanded in custody. Others on bail.
2. Anti Social Behaviour (ASB). Patrols continue in the area affected. One drugs warrant executed (as above).
3. Problem linked to warm weather. SNT are working with land owners to resolve. Targeted Police patrols have taken place. Media release done.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

- CRIME DATA

Crime data is for June 2016. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate. This crime data includes offences at Highpoint prison.

Following last month's publication of crime figures, and subsequent feedback it appears not all Parish Councils are aware of the National Police Crime Data website run by the Home Office. ([www.police.uk](http://www.police.uk)). It's been in existence for some years and is owned and publicised by the Home Office. It contains all your local crime data, stop search data and other similar information. During the implementation of the Suffolk Local Policing Review this information was shared at SALC meetings but we thought we would take this opportunity to remind you of its existence.

If you want to review the crimes reported in your parish you should go to the National Police website and select

- Crime map
- enter your Post Code and drill down as necessary to your local parish.

- There is no obvious pattern or link to the dwelling burglaries / attempted burglaries reported for June. All took place in Haverhill wards. This figure is a reduction from 13 for May 16.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

## - OTHER NEWS

- On 27th July 16, a report was received of an attempted 'distraction' burglary in Majors Close, Chedburgh. Two men entered home purporting to be from roof company. Men tried to request money for work they claimed to have completed. Nothing was stolen. official media release has taken place. CID are investigating.

- We have been able to secure the services of the Norfolk and Suffolk Police, Speed Camera enforcement team during recent weeks. We know that many areas are concerned about speeding and it is good to see so many VAS devices and Speed watch groups out there. The camera team will support our local 'Safer Neighbourhood Team' around enforcement and so we will continue with this.

- During the first week of July, Haverhill suffered around 6 burglaries to sheds and out buildings. This was reported in the media. This series has now stopped.

- On 27th July, proactive staff joined local officers in a day of action against criminals using the roads in Haverhill. They seized 2 x motor vehicles for no insurance and Driving without a licence and reported drivers for failing to wear seat belts, No Insurance, Using mobile phone, No MOT and drive other than in accordance driving licence. Drug and alcohol tests were also done.

## CRIME REDUCTION ADVICE

Property Marking -There are a number of ways of security marking your valuables to protect them against theft and assist police to return them to you if they have been recovered. These include Ultra violet (UV) or invisible marking, Engraving or etching, Ceramic marking or Forensics marking solutions as offered by firms such as Smartwater ([www.smartwater.com](http://www.smartwater.com)) and Selectadna ([www.selectadna.co.uk](http://www.selectadna.co.uk)).

Photograph your valuables - Photographs should be taken against a plain background and include a ruler to give an idea of size.

Close it, Lock it, Check it – Open windows can be seen as opportunities for burglars. Please ensure that downstairs windows and other ones vulnerable to entry are shut. When leaving home check that all windows have been shut and locked.

Review your home security regularly – We suggest you look at the Secured by design – [www.securedbydesign.com](http://www.securedbydesign.com) – for Police approved supplies of everything from Door locks to fencing to intruder alarms.

Cyber Crime – Get Safe Online at [www.getsafeonline.org/norfolksuffolk](http://www.getsafeonline.org/norfolksuffolk) has advice on personal and business internet use including safeguarding children, physical protection of smartphones and tablets. It also has info on the different types of internet fraud, how to protect your internet connection and much more.
