**WE DID...**

1. On-Going priority for Haverhill based on information from the community. Local officers are supported by specialist staff from around the county. Two further drug warrants were executed during November leading to two more arrests (concerned in supply of class A drugs) and drug seizures. One further arrest is also pending.
2. Local businesses contacted by officers, CCTV reviewed to identify the young offenders and an arrest made. Officers tasked to patrol area and engage with youngsters.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

## - UPDATE ON CRIME DATA

Crime data is for October 2016. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate.

-The 7 x Dwelling Burglaries took place in, Cavendish x 1 / Stoke By Clare x 1 / Hundon x 1 / Barnadiston x 1 / Haverhill North x 2 / Haverhill East x 1. They are not all believed to be linked but entry at two of the crime scenes was by forcing windows using garden tools (spade / shovel) All crimes took place on different days during October.

## -EMERGING ISSUES


- We are currently suffering a series of dwelling burglaries in rural areas of West Suffolk. This includes three crimes since 1st December 16 in the Haverhill and Sudbury locality - ( Kedington x 1 and Stoke by Clare x 1 Lavenham x 1. Western area detectives are working on this issue overseen by a detective Inspector. Media releases have previously been done. We do encourage all to report any suspicious activity so that we can consider attendance.

- We have also seen a small number of non dwelling burglaries in the rural areas with suspects breaking into barns or garages and attempting to make off with trailers or motorbikes. Thankfully on one occasion a victim was alerted and managed to scare the intruders away. In a separate incident in Depden last weekend, offenders broke into vehicles after causing damage to a garage door, enquiries are still ongoing.

-Drink Drive Campaign - Don't be a statistic

Its that time of year again when the Christmas parties are in full swing and the merriment begins and everyone likes to enjoy this time of year, and why not, but we need to remind people about the serious message that needs to be borne in mind.

The Constabulary has now commenced its Drink/Drug Driving Campaign which follows the national directive. It goes without saying, please think carefully about organising your night out, ensure there's a dedicated driver in your group, or use a taxi.

Many drivers ignore the risks and drive their vehicle after drinking alcohol or taking illegal drugs. Despite the recent fall in drink-driving convictions, the harm caused by those who still drink-drive is in fact increasing.

Combining illegal drugs with alcohol is especially deadly since it has been found that drivers who have consumed both are 23 times more likely to be involved in a fatal crash than sober drivers. Lets have a SAFE one!
