WE DID...

1. Subject to an on-going operation. Local officers are supported by partners and specialist staff from the county. Now a total of 11 Drug warrants have been executed since mid February. A number of arrests and seizures of drugs/cash. This is likely to be a long term project and we will continue to work on it.
2. (See below for offence detail) - Officers have increase patrols of affected areas. Forensic checks carried out at scenes where appropriate.

Welcome to the second edition of our newsletter which has replaced the old town and parish council reports following the Suffolk local policing review.

Local crime information is still unavailable at this time. Our analytical team are working on the data now and I have been informed by headquarters that the data will be available for the June newsletter.

The 'You said' section above mentions vehicle crime in rural wards. This amounted to seven theft from motor vehicle crimes in Wickhambrook (5) Little Wratting (1) and Haverhill North (1). Items including Sat Nav and tools were stolen. Some but not all vehicles were insecure. Investigations are on-going and we will monitor this series. At time of writing, no further crimes have been reported.
