**YOU SAID...**

1. Tackle the drug dealers and users in Haverhill
2. ASB towards a residential property on the Clements estate.

**WE DID...**

1. On-Going priority for Haverhill based on information from the community. Officers continue to carry out targeted patrols and to execute warrants in areas frequented by persons committing drug related offences. This is covered by a long term Operation - now titled Op Velocity - designed to reduce crime and the fear of crime in relation to drugs around the county.
2. Officers carried out foot and mobile patrols of the area and using surveillance cameras were able to identify those responsible who were dealt with accordingly.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

## - UPDATE ON CRIME DATA

-Crime data is for May 2017. This is to ensure that all crimes during a month are captured accurately. Unfortunately, not all crimes will be reported and counted by the time our newsletter is published (7th of each month) and so this delay ensures that the data received is correct and a true reflection of what has taken place. We will mention any more recent crime series within the further information area if appropriate.

-The 11 Burglaries for May took place in; Haverhill East x 4, Haverhill South x 1, Chedburgh x 1, Wickhambrook x 2 (1 being an attempt), Kedington x 1, Withersfield x 1 and an attempt burglary in Hundon.

Two of these burglaries linked, one in Rede and the other in Barnadiston area due to a vehicle seen, at this time no developments on the possible suspect vehicle. Many of the burglaries involve suspects gaining entry via windows, either secure or insecure and jewellery taken.

-The first Robbery offence occurred on the Haverhill recreation ground when the victim was approached from behind by two males wearing balaclavas and produced a wooden bat and demanded money. Descriptions given as- male, young to early 20's, slim build, approx 5'8" tall, one had a foreign accent and wearing dark clothing.

The other robbery is recorded after officers were dealing with another matter and the victim disclosed a crime. This occurred within a multi occupancy dwelling.

\* When we first become aware of a drug offence, we record a 'holding' crime. This allows time for us to establish what sort of drug offence we are dealing with ie Simple possession / Possession with intent to supply / Conspiracy to supply. It also allows time for a laboratory to check the type of drug. When all of this information is known, the holding crime is changed to to the appropriate 'drug trafficking' offence. This is why the number of crimes does not mirror the action being taken.
