Responding to issues in your community

The team have been working alongside our partner agency 'Havebury' and conducted visits at Anglian Place following reports of tension between neighbouring flats. As a result 2 males have been issued with Community Protection Warning Letters to curb their anti-social behaviour.

Illegal parking outside schools still persists. Sc Oakley attended the area of Westfield primary school and Castle Manor to advise motorists accordingly.

We ask all persons to THINK carefully where they park not to cause an obstruction to nearby residents properties, not to park on the designated area near a pedestrian crossing or on double yellow lines.

Preventing, Reducing and Solving Crime and ASB

Op Velocity which centres on the 'County lines' and the supply of drugs involving gangs originating from an urban city location, in the Haverhill area the gangs are likely to come from London to sell their class A drugs.

This is still high on the Force agenda due to the information still coming through mostly from you the public and we urge everyone to keep updating us with any information which we can assure you will be looked at and assessed.

A male occupant at a property on the Clements estate in Haverhill was served with a notice the other week based on information that drug dealers had taken over his property. No other persons found there at the time of the visit, however the notice explains he commits an offence being the occupier he knowingly permits or suffers the supply of a controlled drug and other associated offences.

We are also in the process of initiating some work around the nuisance vehicles that congregate in the supermarket and public car parks. These vehicle are performing various anti-social driving manoeuvres, leaving litter and playing loud music which is causing nearby residents annoyance. We continue to ask people to report this behaviour via 101 and/or email us, and will collate the information to take this forward and take appropriate action.
