With Haverhill and Clare, together with many of the villages now implementing VAS signs warning motorists of their speed, where possible officers are getting out there with their own speed devices.

A speed check was carried out in Wratting Rd Gt Thurlow with 3 Traffic Offence reports issued and 10 motorists issued with advice, and in Thurlow Rd Gt Bradley 1 TOR issued and 2 given words of advice. Further speed checks carried out in Cavendish Rd Clare on 2 occasions, Ehringshausen Way Haverhill, and in the 40mph zone at Highpoint Stradishall - no offences.

Following the announcement on Twitter that we were looking for a red Golf making off from officers a member of the public called in and the vehicle was subsequently located and seized - they can run but can't hide!

Making the community safer

Pcso Les Scott has been distributing posters that warn people not to become victims of pick pocketing; Remember - keep your purse/wallet out of sight, zip up your bag, wear a shoulder bag across your body, don't leave your bag on a shopping trolley or pushchair.

Distraction thefts can occur at ATM's - Remember to take care when entering your PIN, don't keep the PIN in the same place as your card, be cautious and don't get distracted by anyone even if they approach you.
