1. Op Strudle ASB North West
2. Drug use in Vernon street
3. ASB around Burlington Road, Street drinkers and drug use.

WE DID...

1. This area is continued to be patrolled regularly by the SNT and ASB and crime has significantly reduced. One offender remains in HMP and 2 youths are subject to electronic tag and curfew conditions.
2. There has been an increase in Drug activity in Vernon Street. The West SNT have increased patrols around this area and been working a long side the drugs team and IBC to clean up the area and to identify offenders.
3. The West SNT have had reports of street drinkers and drug use in the area of Burlington Road. Due to this we have been engaging with the public, joint early morning patrols to identify who these people are and to offer support the them. we have also worked along side housing to give reassurance and to identify the offenders of the drug use.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Bridge Ward: A total of 96 investigations were recorded.

A decrease in burglary dwelling with only 2 reported. 2 Robberies reported. A decrease in Theft from Motor vehicles 3 reported and 1 theft of motor vehicle. Continued reports of 2 damages to dwellings and 4 damages to motor vehicles.

Gipping Ward: A total of 127 investigations were recorded.

An increase of burglaries, 2 reported and 2 attempts . 2 robberies and one attempt robbery. Increase in theft from motor vehicles 7 reports. An increase of damage damages to dwelling of 6 and 3 damages to motor vehicles.

Stoke Park: A total of 60 investigations were recorded.

1 report of burglary dwelling, no robberies reported. 1 report of criminal damage to dwelling. A significant reduction in vehicle crime only 2 report of theft from motor vehicle. Positive arrest for drink driving where another motorist has been banned from driving.

Sprites: A total of 65 investigations were recorded.

1 report of Attempt Burglary dwelling. No robberies reported. 2 theft from motor vehicles and 1 report of damage to dwelling.

Castle Hill: A total of 20 investigations were recorded.

No burglary dwellings reported. An overall reduction in vehicle crime with one theft from motor vehicle and one damage to motor vehicle. 2 youths remain on electronic tag and subject to curfew conditions

Whitehouse: A total of 80 investigations were recorded.

A significant decrease in burglary dwelling with 3 reports investigations ongoing to identify offenders. An overall reduction in vehicle crime, 1 report of theft of motor vehicle and 1 report of theft from motor vehicle. 2 Youths are currently on police bail pending investigation SNT continue to work with partner agencies targeting youth activities.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Whitton: A total of 79 investigations recorded.

3 reports of Dwelling Burglary reported. One male has been arrested and charged with Burglary dwelling. There has been a decrease to damages across the area, 4 damages to vehicles and 3 to dwellings. Police are continuing with their enquiries to identify offenders, if you've seen anything suspicious please ring 101. Vehicle crime has significantly decreased, 1 report of attempt theft of motor vehicle and 3 theft from motor vehicles.

- Keep your doors locked at all times, even when you are in the house or in your garden, but especially when you go out.
- Do not leave any keys in locks or close to doors or windows. Make sure you have a fire plan so you can get out in the case of a fire.
- Avoid keeping valuable jewellery in obvious places eg - jewellery boxes, under the bed or at the bottom of the wardrobe in the master bedroom.
- If using a safe please ensure this is secured to a solid floor see www.securedbydesign.com for details.
- Take photographs of all such items (laid beside a ruler) & store these in a safe place.
- Register all valuable items on www.immobilise.com
- Large quantities of cash should never be kept at home.
- Do not leave bricks or tools etc in the garden that could be used to break glass or force entry with.
- Keep back gates locked, with key operated lock eg padlock and make sure that there is nothing that could be used to climb over with, such as a wheelie bin.
