### Responding to issues in your community

There have been a spate of residential burglaries across Ipswich. We have been working with our Response and CID colleagues to patrol Central Ipswich and identify suspects. We recommend that residents photograph all valuable items, mark work tools and utilise Immobilise.com to register these items

### Preventing, reducing and solving crime and ASB

During December 124 shoplifting offences were reported in the Town Centre. 56 offences have resulted in a charge to court, 5 people were cautioned, 14 Community Resolutions and 1 penalty ticket issued.
