FURTHER INFORMATION

In June, Central SNT applied to The Court and were successful in having a Criminal Behavior Order issued against Micheal Joesph SMITH. He is prevented from entering the main Town Centre area for 3 years. This was following his persistent anti social behavior in The Town Centre.

If he breaches this order he can be arrested and maybe imprisoned.

A successful theft act warrant was executed at an address in The Central SNT area - this saw a large quantity of stolen pedal cycles recovered, along with cannabis, cash and cigarettes and alcohol that had not had duty paid on them. Two persons were arrested and have been charged with multiple offences.

We are currently in the process of reuniting owners with their stolen bikes!

- Immobilise helps Police identify the owners of recovered property thousands of times everyday.
- Property updates you make are immediately available to the Police nationally.
- Combat the sale of stolen gadgets & valuables; alert the second-hand trade & publicly checkable stolen goods database CheckMEND if an item goes missing.
- Simplify insurance claims and Police reports with certificates of ownership.

HELP OUR HOMELESS

We are continuing our work with our partners around homelessness, rough sleeping and begging, which has seen an increase in Ipswich.

A new multi-agency initiative, Help Our Homeless, has launched in Ipswich which aims to highlight all of the really good, proactive work and outreach work happening.


The group are seeking to help those who are homeless and those at risk of becoming homeless through referrals to relevant agencies, charities and other partners.
