
You said...

During the month of December 2018 there was a total of 580 investigations in the East of Ipswich. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals).

Criminal Offences recorded range from various assaults and public order offences to theft and burglary and drug possession.

PCSO Gemma Read has now started her new fully funded role in Kesgrave and Rushmere St Andrew. Based at the North East Safer Neighbourhood Team Office on Heath Road Ipswich PCSO Gemma Read will be tasked to undertake visible patrols, tackle low level ASB and provide any local policing advice as required. There will be a chance for members of the public to speak to their PCSO during regular Police Surgeries.
