## YOU SAID...

1. ASB occurring on Rushmere Heath.
2. ASB use of mopeds, motorbikes on open spaces around East Ipswich
3. ASB at Selkirk Road, Coop.

## WE DID...

1. We have targeted patrols in and around the heath. Encountering young people and dealing with any ASB including underage drinking and criminal damage. School visits have taken place and a number of young people have been spoken to in the presence of their parents. The SNT will continue to monitor this area and deal with any ASB direct.
2. The use of mopeds and motorbikes on the open spaces around the East of Ipswich, continues to cause issues. However, our team are pro-actively targeting those individuals responsible. We have recently issued Section 59 warnings to moped users, one who was riding in an anti social manner, and another for carrying a passenger who was not wearing a crash helmet. This pro-active approach will continue, along with Engaging with users of the areas concerned offering advice and reassurance.
3. Our SNT officers in conjunction with the antisocial manager from East of England COOP, are working towards engaging with the youth and their families to understand what the issues and concerns are. Both the Police and the COOP will work towards a long term solution for the community. At this time several youth have received community resolutions for their behaviour and we continue to meet and engage any unruly behaviour head on.

47 Investigations. 2 burglary offences, 2 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 10 theft offences.

**RUSHMERE:**

43 Investigations. 0 burglary offences, 2 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 10 theft offences.

**RUSHMERE ST ANDREW:**

8 Investigations. 0 burglary offences, 0 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 5 theft offences.

**GAINSBOROUGH:**

80 Investigations. 1 burglary offence, 6 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle). 11 theft offences.

**PRIORY HEATH:**

139 Investigations. 0 burglary offences, 8 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 15 theft offences.

**HOLYWELLS:**

99 Investigations. 5 burglary offences, 5 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 32 theft offences.

**KESGRAVE:**

40 Investigations. 3 burglary offences, 6 criminal damage offences (both building & vehicle), 9 theft offences.

Difference in detailed offences to totals will be made up of such things as public order offences, domestic incidents and harassment along with other agency referrals.

# FURTHER INFORMATION

Here are our current priorities set on 21st June 2016:

1. Public open spaces – ASB and use of mopeds, motorbikes & off road bikes
2. Selkirk Road Co-op – ASB
3. Rushmere Heath – ASB, drinking & drug taking

There are a number of ways you can get in touch with Suffolk Constabulary depending on the urgency and type of request.

By telephone in an emergency always dial 999. Dialing 999 is a must if you are facing an incident or crime right now and you need police help immediately.

The Suffolk Constabulary non-emergency number 101 is the number to call when you want to contact police when it is less urgent than 999.

The non-emergency number is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Alternatively you can report a crime online.

If you want to speak to your local Safer Neighbourhood Team and it's not urgent using email will be quickest and if you want any member of the team will get back to you within 24hrs. The SNT email address is:

If you have an issue with how the police have handled a local community matter, such as dealing with an incident of ASB, or if you have an issue relating to something like a series of crimes occurring in your area, we advise that you speak to your locality Inspector Roger Salmon, to highlight your concerns. Inspector Salmon will be able to review the circumstances of the incident/matter and our response and make an assessment about how it is handled.
